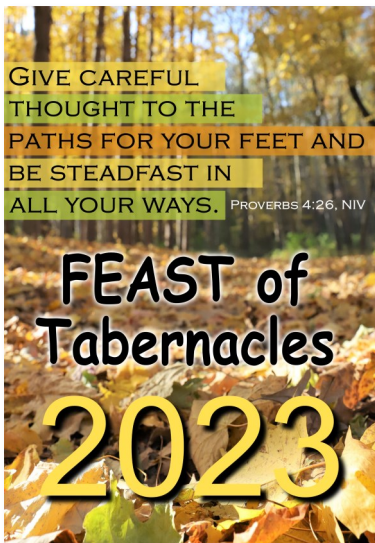

## Feast of Tabernacles 2023

Is it too early to start planning and preparing for the Feast of Tabernacles 2023? Not at all, especially this year. Our last location was already reserved this year in October by a maintenance crew that comes out for the nuclear plant (yes, there is one in the neighborhood) every three years. We looked at other locations, and prices have skyrocketed. Others were excited at first, then, when we told them the name of the assembly, it became clear they were not interested in having us there. Too bad, because we leave places cleaner when we depart, than when we arrive.



This year, if we see the new moon when expected, for our North American region, we'll be having the Feast of Tabernacles at the Assembly property on October 1st through the 7th, with the Eighth Day on October 8th.

Accommodations will be an individual responsibility. We have tent sites on the property, but you must supply your own tent. In addition, there are numerous motels within three miles of YAIY. You must secure your own motel reservations. Phone numbers of the local motels can be provided if needed. [www.booking.com](http://www.booking.com) is recommended.

Before all of this, of course, is Trumpets and Atonement. For many of us, we've at least had a few years of practice looking for the new moon in our respective areas, and when the Feast dates should fall on. However, for those that are new, this is all unfamiliar territory. It takes time but this is part of our training for the reigning.

The Hebrew word *miqra* appearing in Leviticus chapter 23 means a "convocation" or, "summons of meeting" in the context of the *moedim*, the appointed times. It is a call to gather in preparation for a future event. In this case, it's in reference to the coming Kingdom of Yahweh and after it, new beginnings, or time out of time — in other words, eternity, represented by what is also called the Last Great Day. While there are those who don't understand why we are doing these things, the rewards for doing so are quite literally, out of this world. We recommend urgency rather than procrastination toward doing Yahweh's will.

What then should be our attitude? It should not be like those who make excuses, as in the following parable (a figurative way of explaining a serious truth):

## Feast of Tabernacles 2023 ...,cont.

Yahshua spoke to them again in parables, saying: “The kingdom of heaven is like a king who prepared a wedding banquet for his son. He sent his servants to those who had been invited to the banquet to tell them to come, but they refused to come. Then he sent some more servants and said, ‘Tell those who have been invited that I have prepared my dinner: My oxen and fattened cattle have been butchered, and everything is ready. Come to the wedding banquet.’ But they paid no attention and went off— one to his field, another to his business. The rest seized his servants, mistreated them and killed them. The king was enraged. He sent his army and destroyed those murderers and burned their city. Then he said to his servants, “The wedding banquet is ready, but those I invited did not deserve to come. So go to the street corners and invite to the banquet anyone you find.” So the servants went out into the streets and gathered all the people they could find, the bad as well as the good, and the wedding hall was filled with guests. But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing wedding clothes. He asked, “How did you get in here without wedding clothes, friend?” The man was speechless. Then the king told the attendants, “Tie him hand and foot, and throw him outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. For many are invited, but few are chosen,” Matthew 22:1–14, NIV.



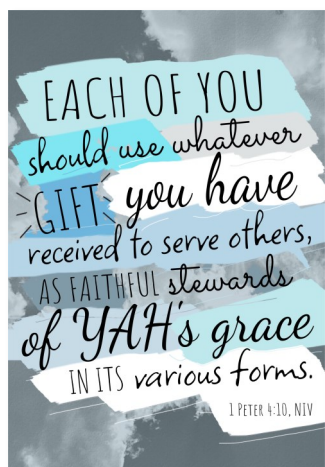

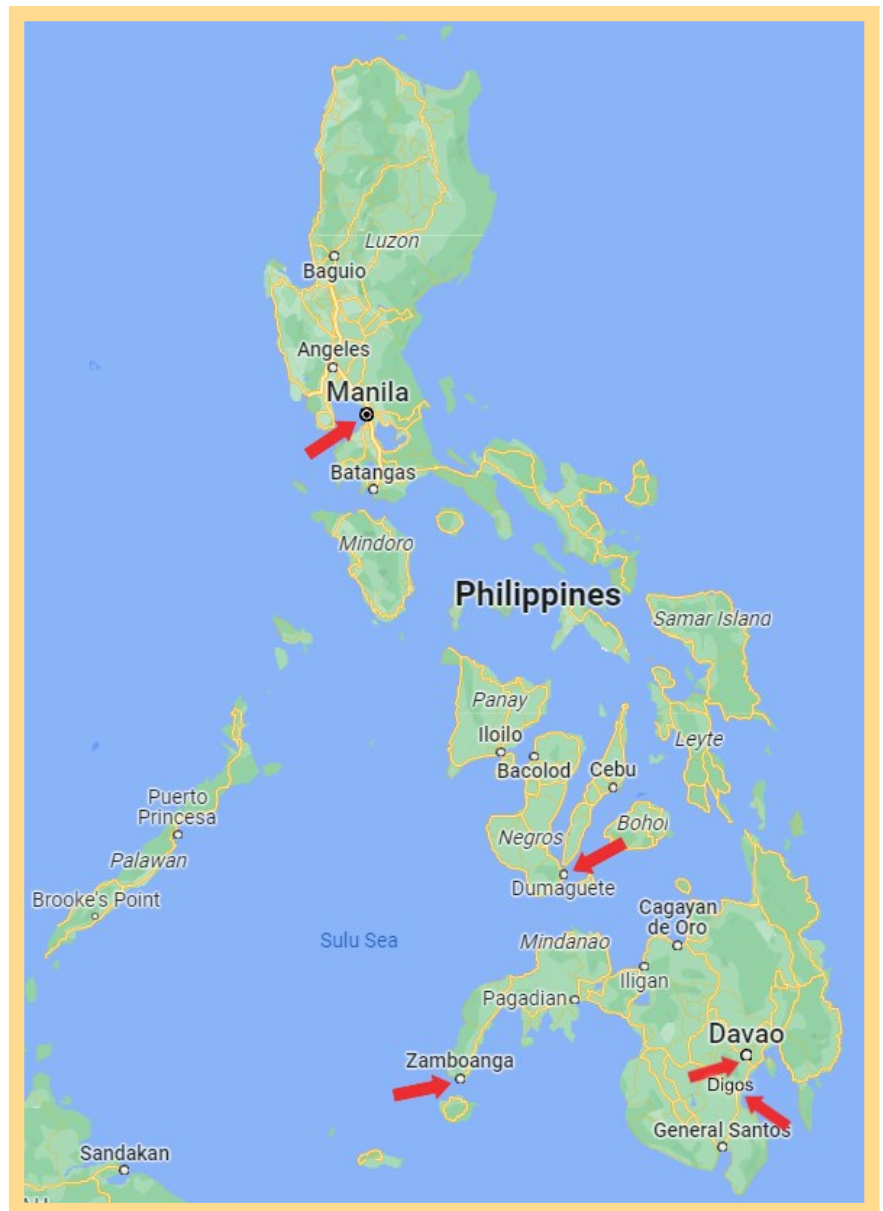
## Philippines Trip

And, YES, we trust we'll be able to get some good traveling footage to share with everyone.



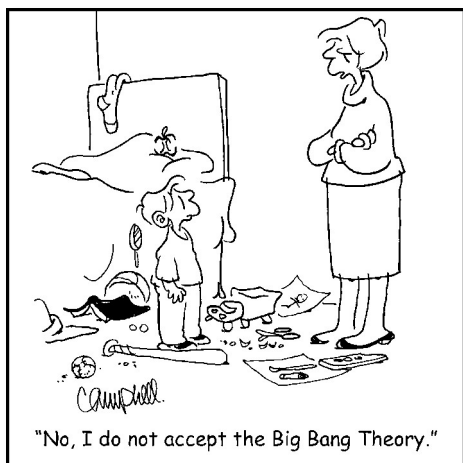


## BIG BANG Theory?

“No small number of my colleagues consider it their first task, to educate students about the myth and harm of creation science.
