circumspectly, and give attendance to the sanctuary, they, too, should be overcome by all that is in, and of, the world. Thus, the reason Yahshua declared that only “he who endures to the end shall be saved” (Matt. 10:22).

As a matter of fact, the sanctuary, as that place where the Assembly, the Pillar and Ground of the Truth, meets on the Sabbath for Holy Convocation, is a place of safety and refuge for us who have been called out and separated from all that is the rest of the world. For we, like our fathers before us, confess ourselves but strangers and pilgrims on the earth, desiring and looking for that better place whose foundations are built and made of Yahweh (Heb. 11:10-16).

And while it is easy to dismiss them which are crooked and froward; wicked and evil; adulterous and perverse; faithless and untoward, and judge them unfit for redemption, salvation, and deliverance, it should be even easier ourselves, to turn from the Holy Commandment delivered us. But it would be better instead, to assume the disposition of the Psalmist who wrote that in beholding wicked transgressors, he was grieved; that horror had taken hold upon him and in their behalf, “rivers of water had run down his eyes” (Psa. 119:158, 53, 136). Even Yahshua, toward the end of His ministry, beheld the city Jerusalem, and wept ... foreseeing that day when Roman legions should cast a trench about it on every side, and lay it even with the ground, leaving not one stone upon another (Luke 19:41-44). And why should He weep? because like in the days of our fathers, and in our day, men know not the time of their visitation.

Indeed, blessed are they that grieve over men’s sins, for they shall be called near to Yahweh (Matt. 5:4).
