

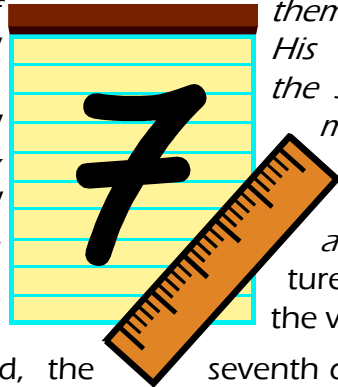

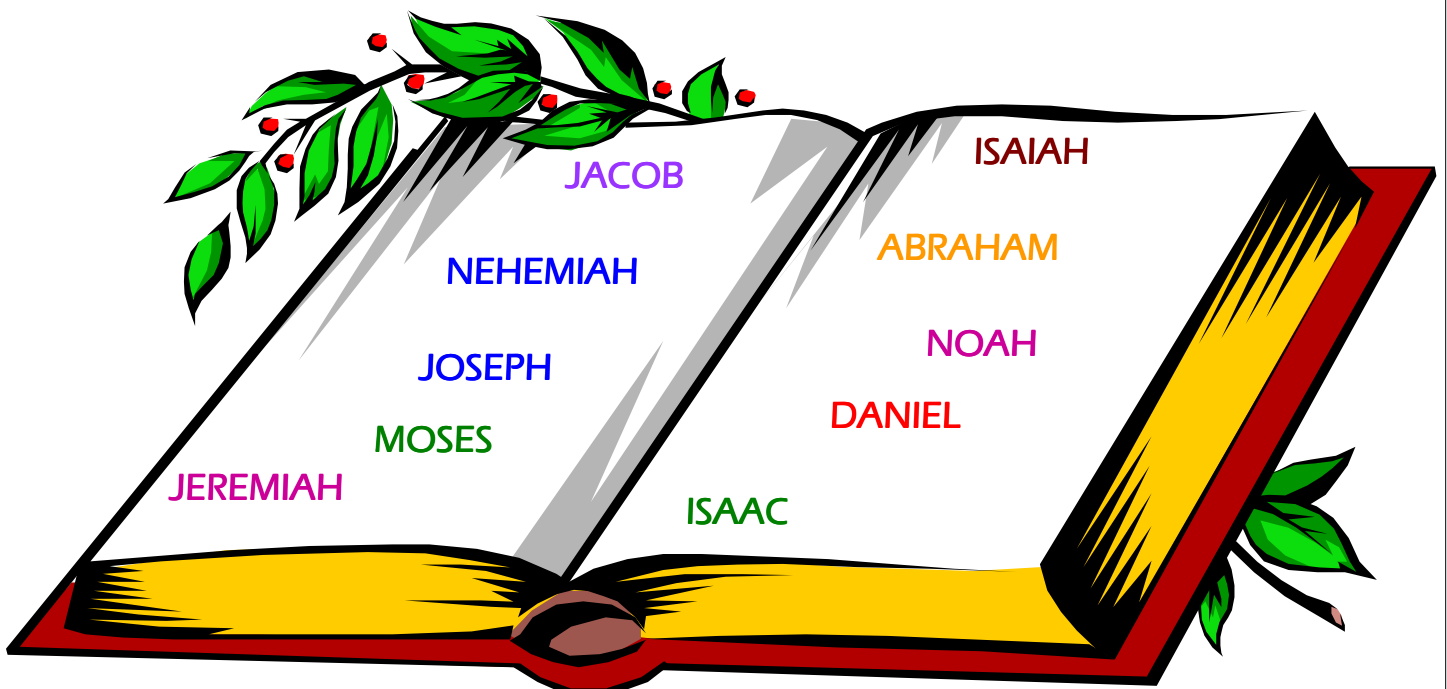

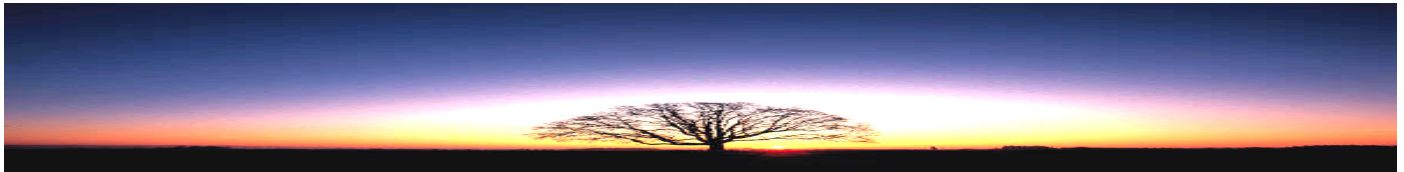

## MAKING THE SABBATH A DELIGHT: IDEAS FOR FAMILIES

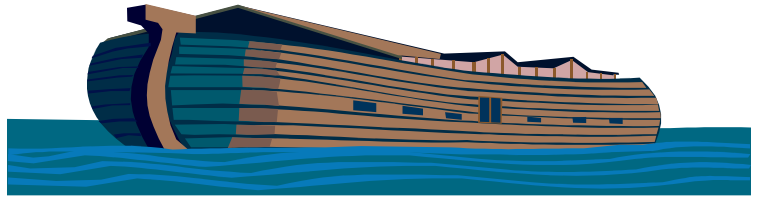
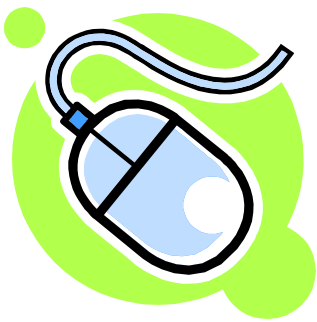
1. Take turns reading the Bible, then discuss each chapter that you finish reading.

### *How Big was Noah's Ark?*

*When Yahweh decided to destroy the earth because of mankind's wickedness, He told Noah to build an ark 300 cubits long. Most scholars believe that a cubit is the distance from an adult's fingertips to his elbow, about 18 inches. If this is accurate, the ark would have been at least 450 feet—absolutely enormous! An ark that large could certainly hold all the animals that Yahweh commanded Noah to load on board. A structure such as the ark would need a huge ocean to float on, and there was no ocean anywhere near Noah's home. But Yahweh caused it to rain for 40 days and 40 nights. So the ark did float and Yahweh preserved mankind because of Noah's obedience.*
