Counting to Pentecost!

In the Greek, Pentecost means "count 50." We know that Pentecost was most definitely observed in the Old Testament, but what is the significance of Pentecost in the New Testament? Something very incredible happened to Yahshua's followers on the day of Pentecost!

Fish and Loaves snack activity

Hey Kids for Yah! You will need your parents permission and assistance in doing this activity. First, lets read about an amazing miracle!



We all love reading stories in the Bible about the miracles Yahshua performed when He lived on the earth two thousand years. One of our favorites involves Him feeding a large crowd of people using only some fish and bread that a little boy supplied. The story is found in John 6, and Yahshua was able to feed five thousand people! This demonstrated Yahshua's power as Yah-

weh's own Son. The disciples learned a powerful lesson that day too. Having faith is crucial to getting our prayers answered. Now let's do a fun activity with the help of your parents.

Make a snack basket of fish and bread

All you'll need is a small box of fish shaped crackers, paper lunch bags, non-toxic all-purpose glue, and 2 cans of refrigerated biscuits.

Step 1: Divide each biscuit into 3 parts. Flatten each one out on wax paper and bake according to package instructions.

Step 2: While biscuits are baking, make a "basket" with the paper lunch bag. Measure about 4 inches from the bottom of the bag and cut off. Use the parts that were cut off to make a handle for your basket by cutting a strip that can fit over the top of the basket. Glue and let dry well. Feel free to use colorful ribbons as a handle if you prefer. You can also decorate your baskets in any way you like!
