4. Always stay close to Yahweh in prayer and study and ask for His help in trying to honor your parents properly.



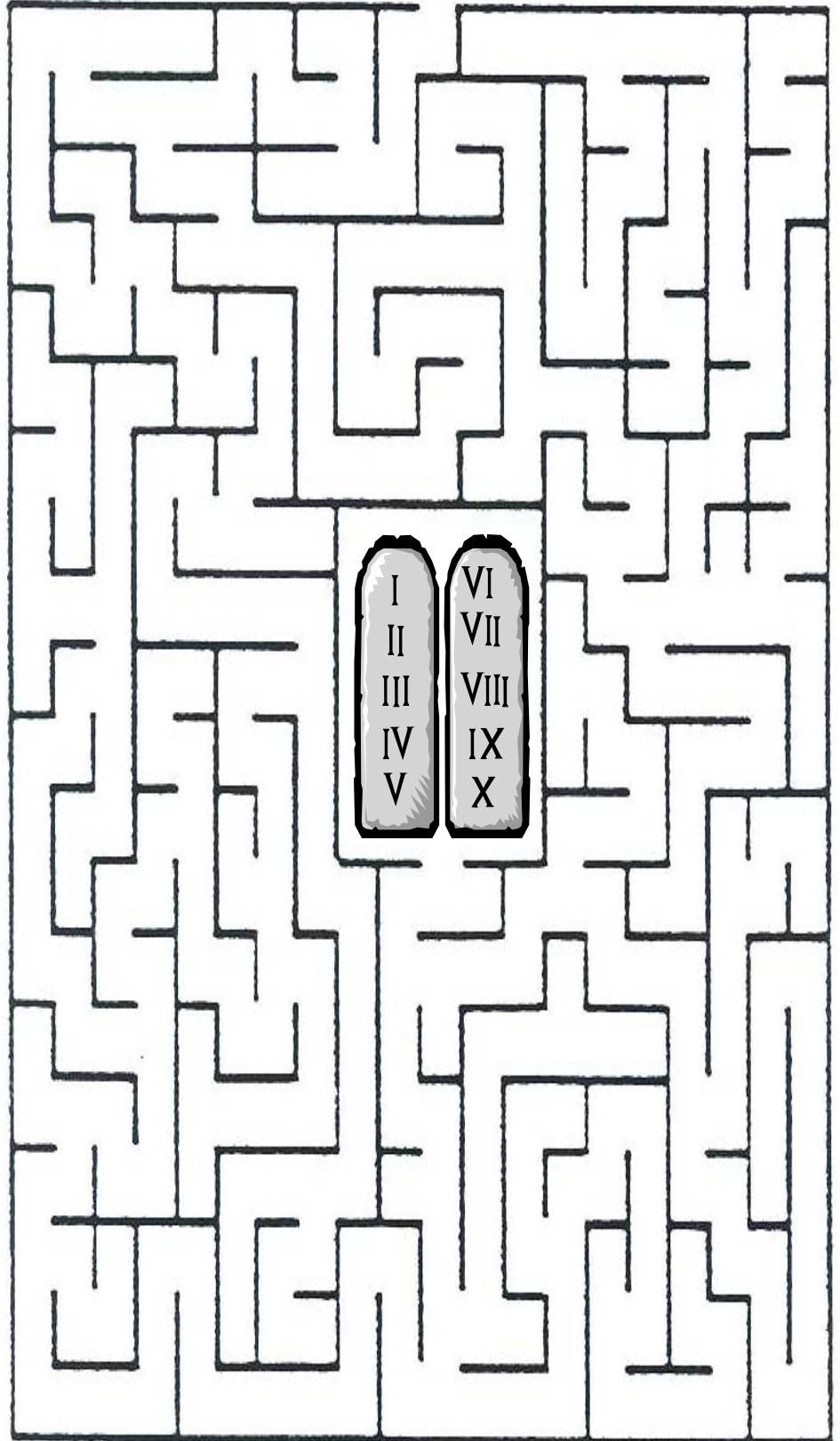

3. Yahshua showed honor to His earthly mother and likewise we need to honor our earthly parents.

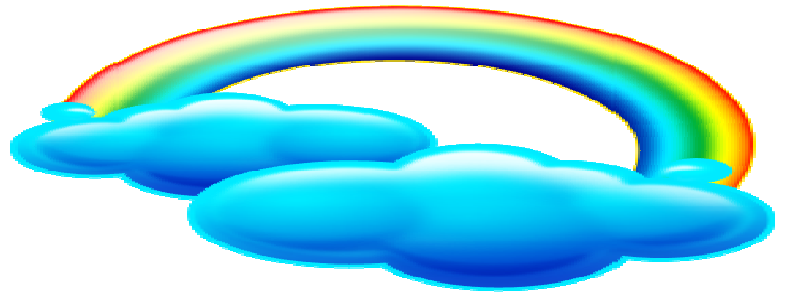
There are numerous ways in which we can "follow the footsteps" of Yahshua. Below, mark the boxes that show ways to do the things that Yahshua wants:

Rainbow-colored Message

There are many promises in the Bible and one of the most well-known is the rainbow. Yahweh promised never to destroy the earth again by a flood and we are reminded of this every time we see a rainbow. Most everyone enjoys seeing rainbows as they also remind us of Yahweh's love for His creation. We are also expected to love others too. In order, these are the colors of rainbows: Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Indigo, and Violet. Follow this sequence and color the letter blocks below one at a time. For example, color "L" red, the first "O" orange, "V" yellow, and so on, until you reach violet, then start from red again.
