Count 50

This month we will be keeping Pentecost. The Greek word *pentecoste* translated "Pentecost" means to count 50. It has also been called, "Feast of Weeks" or "Feast of Firstfruits." The early disciples in the book of Acts were still faithfully keeping this special day, even after Yahshua's death, and we should be keeping it, too! This was a very eventful day for the disciples. Prior to that day, in general, the Holy Spirit was not given to many people. But now everyone can receive the gift of the Holy Spirit upon repentance, baptism, and the laying on of hands. It was poured out on the disciples and appeared as tongues of fire above their heads! The day of Pentecost is considered the birth or beginning of the New Testament Assembly. In the Greek, the word is *ekklesia* and means "called out ones."

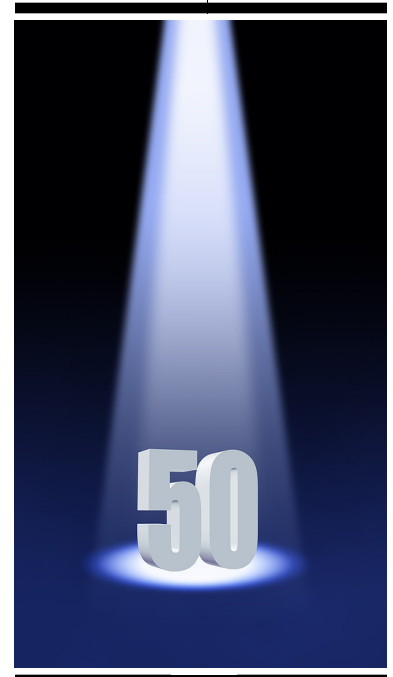

Let's read about Pentecost in Leviticus 23:15-16, "And you shall count from the morrow after the Sabbath from the day that you brought the wave sheaf of the wave offering; seven Sabbaths shall be complete. Even unto the morrow after the seventh Sabbath you shall number 50 days; and you shall offer a new meat offering unto Yahweh." So we can see why in

the Greek language, Pentecost came to be associated with the number 50.

The day of Pentecost is also associated with a harvest of firstfruits. Yahshua was the Firstfruit. We, too, can be firstfruits in the first resurrection. We can be raised to immortality and have eternal life. Let us rejoice on the day of Pentecost.

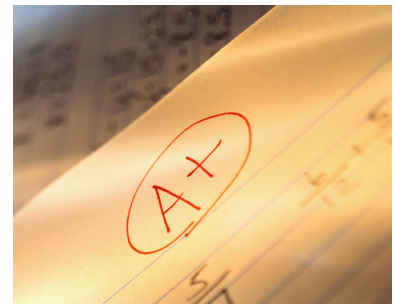

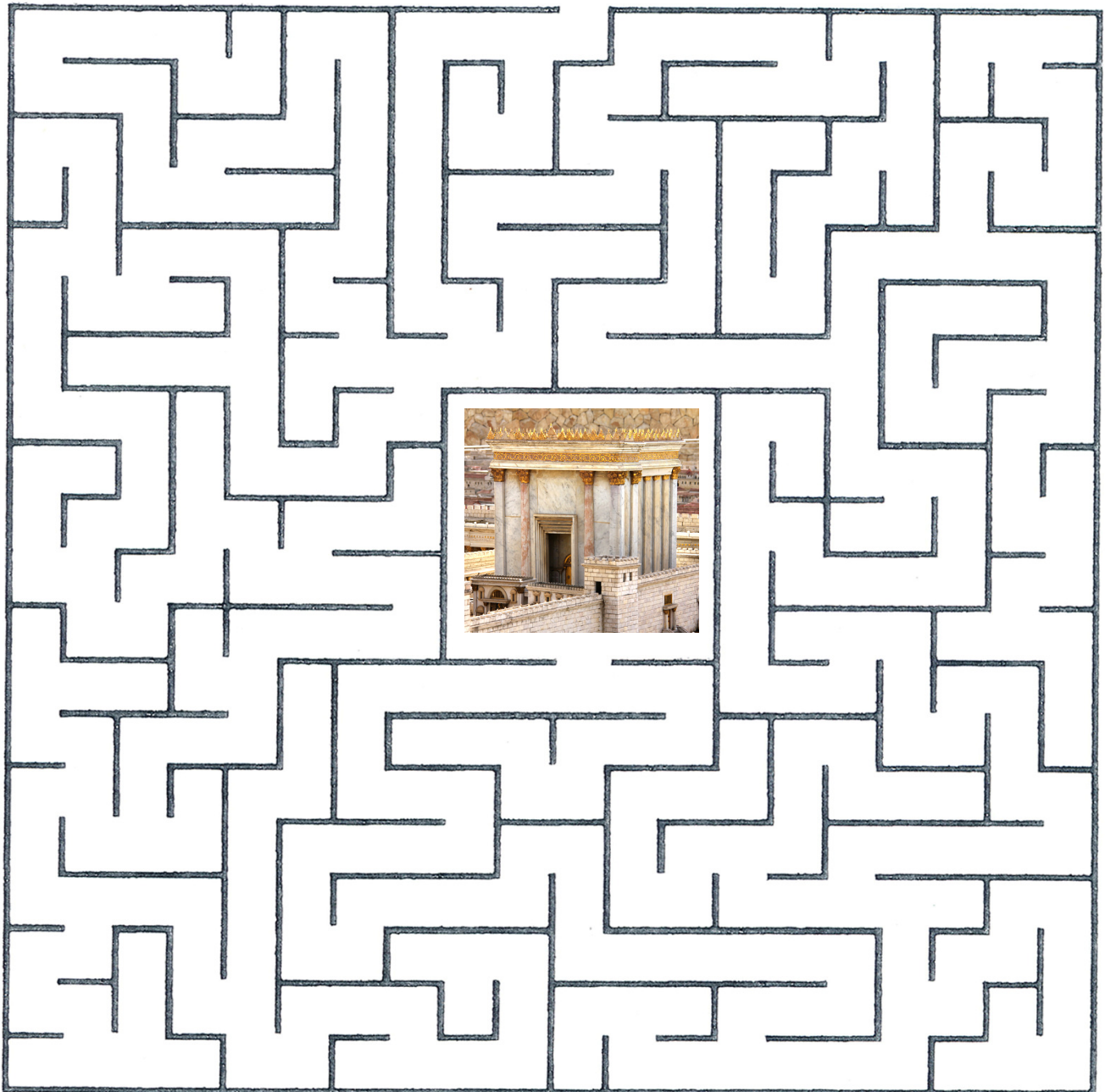

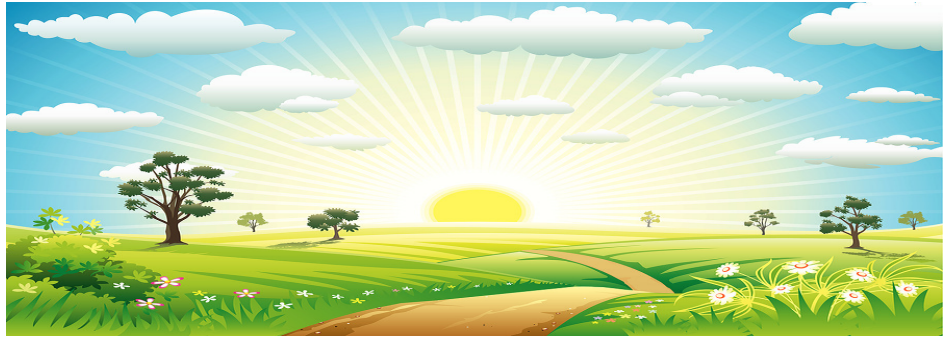
