The king served Daniel and his three friends rich food from the king's own table. But Daniel followed Yahweh's food laws, so he knew he had to be very careful about what he ate. The Babylonians did not follow Yahweh's food laws, so they probably ate unclean meats and seafood, which Yahweh did not intend as food. So Daniel and his friends ate vegetables and water for ten days. After ten days, King Nebuchadnezzar found that they were much healthier and stronger by observing kosher laws.

Yahweh also gave Daniel the gift of interpreting dreams. King Nebuchadnezzar had been troubled by bad dreams and Yahweh revealed to Daniel what the dreams meant. Even the wise men of Babylon were not able to interpret the dreams. But King Nebuchadnezzar made many mistakes. He built a large idol and demanded that everyone bow down and worship it. In fact, Daniel's three friends refused and were thrown into a fiery furnace as punishment. But Yahweh saved them from it.

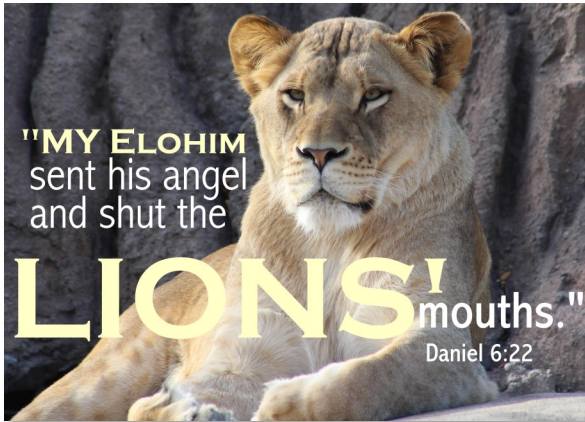

We must obey Yahweh, and not men when they ask us to do wrong.

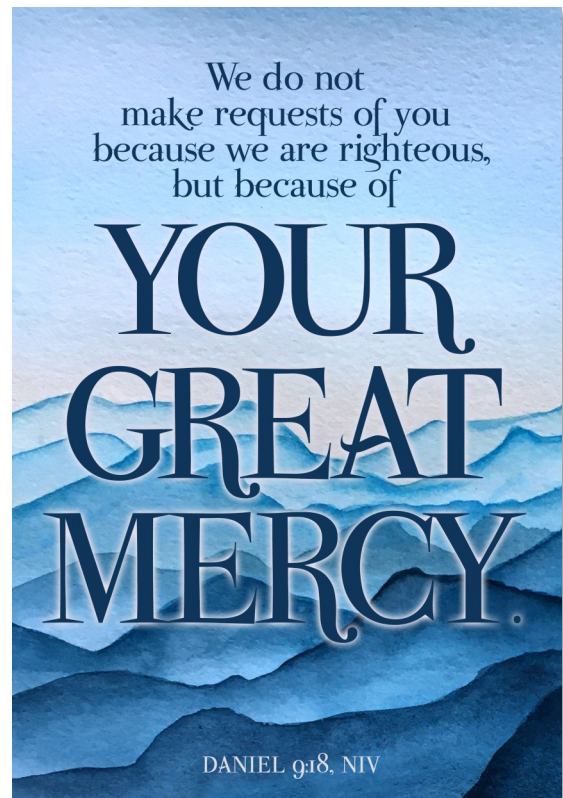

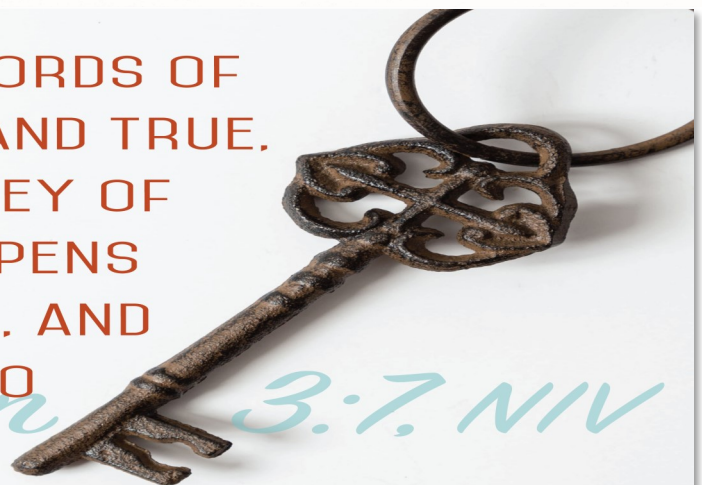

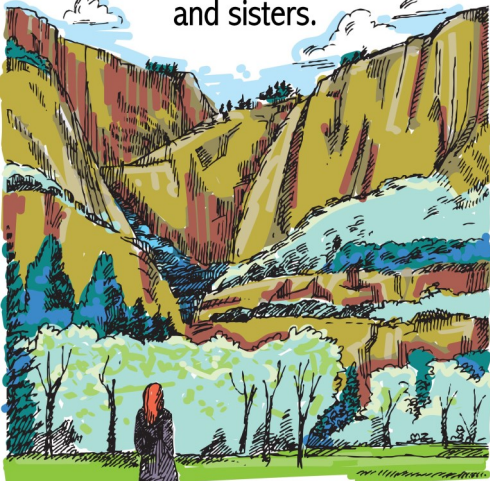
