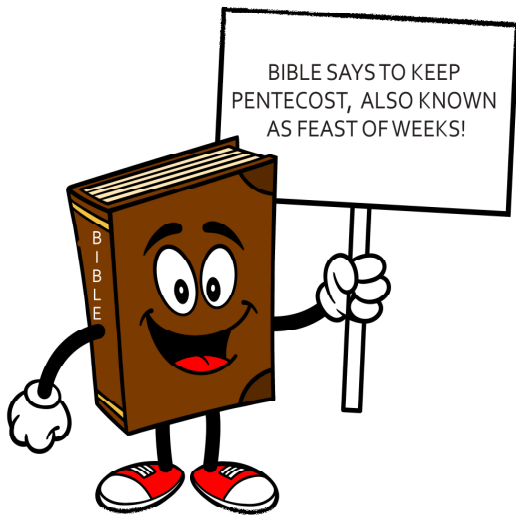

Let's learn about Pentecost



As most of you know, we will be celebrating Pentecost this month. A lot can be said about Pentecost. It was originally called Feast of Weeks in the Old Testament. In the New Testament, it is called Pentecost, which means "count 50" in the Greek. Pentecost is related to a wheat harvest, which is why many people read the book of Ruth during this time period. Ruth was a poor widow who was redeemed by her kinsman, Boaz. Many

people see similarities between Boaz and Yahshua. Yahshua redeems us from death and complete destruction. He gives us hope for a bright future.

In the New Testament, it is also mentioned that Pentecost was the day the early believers received the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit appeared at "tongues of fire" above their heads. They spoke in tongues, which means "languages." This was actually the official beginning of the early Assembly. The Spirit was not widely poured out in Old Testament times. It was generally given to specific individuals to fulfill a certain purpose. But now, any baptized adult who accepts Yahshua can receive it.

Yahweh's people were commanded to keep the Feast of Weeks in the Old Testament, and we are still commanded to keep it today. All of Yahweh's Holy Days are important and show us the plan of salvation.
