## THE EIGHTH DAY

We are well into Yahweh's Fall Holy days, which includes the Feast of Trumpets, Day of Atonement, the Feast of Tabernacles, and the Eighth Day. The Feast of Tabernacles lasts



seven days. The Eighth Day is a separate Holy Day, but is kept right after the seventh day of the Feast of Tabernacles. Like all of Yahweh's Holy days, it begins and ends at sundown. The world's calendars begin their new days at midnight, which is not what Scripture teaches. The Eighth day is a holy convocation, meaning it is a special high day on which we meet.

So, in Yahweh's plan of salvation, what does the Eighth day represent? It represents eternity, time out of time, and a new beginning. It will also be the quenching of spiritual thirst placed upon all mankind without measure (John 7:37).

Yahweh's Holy Days greatly show Yahweh's plan of salvation, unlike the world's holidays. Right after Yahweh's fall holy days, comes a rush of pagan holidays beginning with the evil celebration of Halloween. Some people say it is an innocent and fun holiday, but you can easily research the roots of Halloween and instantly see why you should avoid participating it. 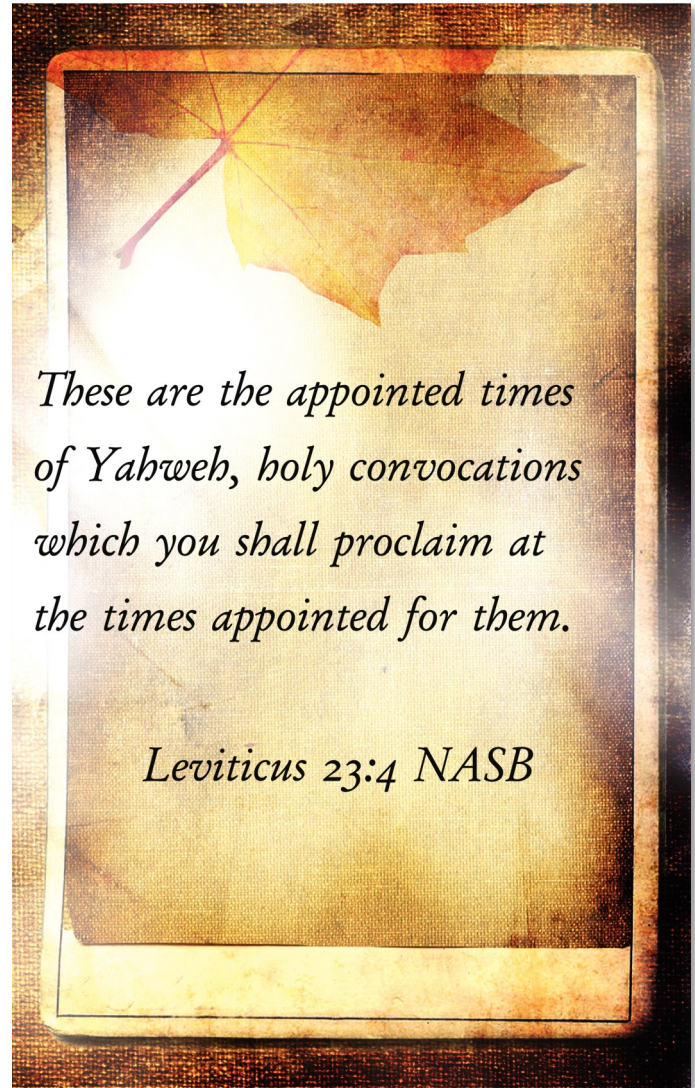

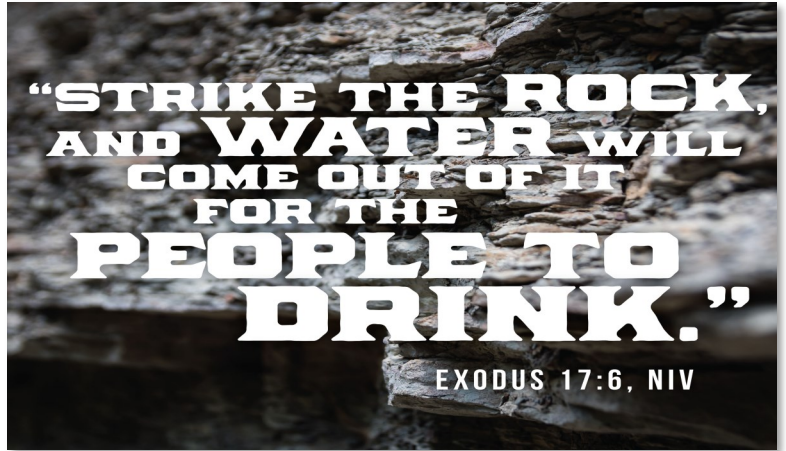

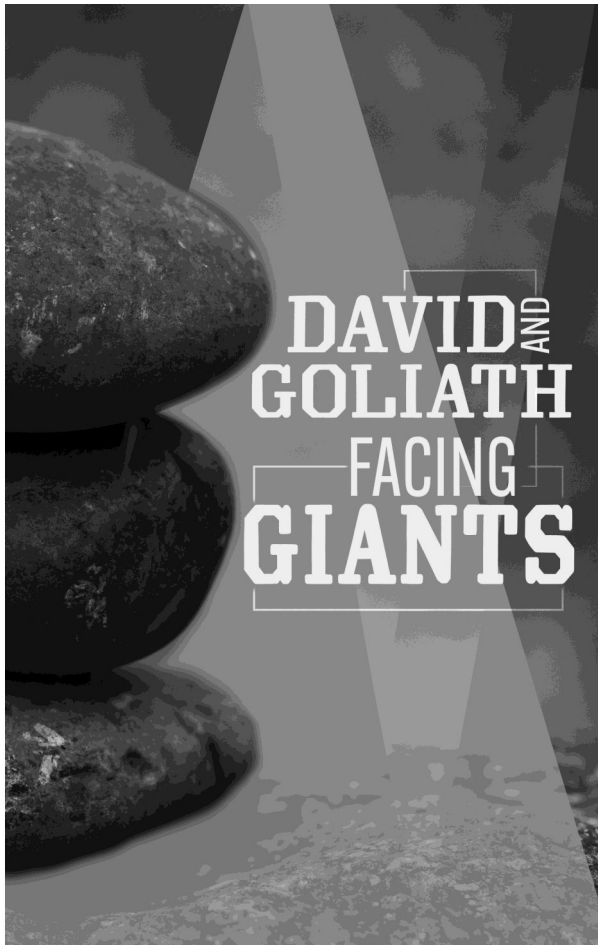
