Psalm 86:5 says, "You, Yahweh, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to You." Also read Matthew 6:14-15, which tells us, "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 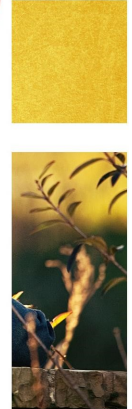
