#### Are You as Confused as I Was?

I grew up in a mainstream, Sunday-keeping church and attended regularly with my parents and family as long as I can remember. As I began to understand the Bible and read it for myself, troublesome questions arose. Concepts were being taught that were not found in the Bible. The Sunday School teacher had no answers and was as perplexed as I.



One of these inconsistencies centered on the three days and three nights of the Savior's death and resurrection. I was taught a Friday afternoon death followed by a Sunday morning resurrection. Even after drawing out a chart and labeling the days and nights, the best I could come up with was one full day and parts of two days, but only two nights within that span. But my Bible said in Matthew 12:40 the Messiah would be a full three days and three nights in the grave.

The Sunday School teacher urged me to see the minister of the church to get answers from him. This, too, troubled me because it appeared as if there was a special way of reading the Bible that had to be learned at a seminary. He was really saying the Bible was not meant to be read by common people like myself. The pastor's explanation was superficial and incomplete.

One of the most shocking teachings I encountered was that people ignorant of the Bible and the Messiah (through no fault of their own) would immediately go to an ever-burning hell fire upon death. I questioned why a person should be so everlastingly, excruciatingly punished because he had never had anyone tell him of the Bible and the Redeemer Who was sent to save him.


Suppose he was on his way to his first revival service and his car broke down so that he could not reach the meeting. He would never have heard of the Good News of salvation, but would suffer eternal torture because of it. It just did not seem right. How could a loving, compassionate, Heavenly Father condemn him to an ever-burning hell fire for something beyond his control? Yet, that is what many believe and teach today.

I also had problems in trying to reconcile a future resurrection as promised in Scripture with the church's teaching that said that immediately upon

death the soul of the individual went either to heaven or to hell. I was told that as the body is put in the ground the soul goes either to a heavenly bliss or to everlasting punishment.

But wait. If the soul was already free of the body and could pass through doors, hear, and see without the body, what was the point of a resurrection? The Bible says that in the resurrection the body will be raised from the dust of the earth (Dan. 12:2). Would the soul be yanked from heavenly bliss or fiery hell, put back in a resurrected body, and then redeposited in heaven or hell? Why would a resurrection from the dead be necessary anyway if the soul is already living elsewhere? The minister had no good explanation.

I was told there were many difficulties that were mine simply because I did not understand what the Bible really meant. These were mysteries, they said. When I read that the noble Bereans consulted the Scriptures daily whether these things are true, it seemed to me that I should be able to search the Scriptures, also, and come up with some solid answers. After all, my eternal future lay with my understanding of Bible truths.

But the Bible was not written for the common man, they said. If this be the case, then how could I possibly understand anything that was written? I had never been to a Bible school or studied under one of the religious teachers of our day. And how was I to "work out my own salvation with fear and trembling" (Phil. 2:12), if it was left to someone else's interpretation?

Maybe you find yourself facing the same confusion and contradictions I did. Does what you read in the Bible conflict with what you are being taught? Are you leaving your future, everlasting life in the hands of someone else, trusting in what he or she says rather than digging out the truth for yourself?

Your very salvation depends on whether you will accept the truth of the Bible and act on it. It is your responsibility and only yours. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of the Messiah; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to what he has done, whether it be good or bad, 2 Corinthians 5:10. No one can speak for you then. You will not be able to plead ignorance on the grounds you did not understand or that you relied on someone else's explanation.

Be assured there are plain, simple, logical answers to the questions you may be facing right now. You can understand the Bible by allowing the Holy Spirit to guide you. Help is available.

The opportunity is now. Don't let it slip by.
