Worthy Is The Lamb


And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; Saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory and blessing," Revelation 5:11-12.

Just Who is this Lamb Who is worthy of all laud, admiration and exaltation? Why is He referred to as a Lamb, and what significance does His death have to extol Him?

The Witness of Scripture

Scripture holds the answers to these questions, and it is thereto we will now look. But where does one begin?

Isaiah 28:9-10 asks, Whom shall He teach knowledge? And whom shall He make to understand doctrine? [Them that are] weaned from the breasts. For precept [must be] upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, [and] there a little.



John the Baptist, upon seeing Yahshua said, Behold the Lamb of Yahweh, Which takes away the sin of the world, John 1:29. It was the Holy Spirit within John which opened his eyes; John had been preaching of One coming saying, There comes One mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose. I indeed have baptized you with water: but He shall baptize you with the Holy Spirit...And Yahshua, when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water, and lo, the heavens were opened unto Him, and He saw the Spirit of Yahweh descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him: and lo a voice from heaven, saying, "This is My Beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased," Mark 1:7-8; Matthew 3:16-17.


John the apostle also bore witness of Yahshua's preeminence:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Elohim, and the Word was Elohim. The Same was in the beginning with Elohim. All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was

made...And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only Begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth, John 1:1-3, 14.

The Apostle Paul bore witness of the same in writing, Who is the Image of the Invisible El, the Firstborn of every creature: for by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether [they] be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him: and He is before all things, and by Him all things consist, Colossians 1:15-17.

This was written in reference to Yahshua, the One, In Whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins, Colossians 1:14.

So, to gain yet a better understanding of just Who Yahshua is, we will now look to the prophet Isaiah who wrote, Yet it pleased Yahweh to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief: when You shall make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of Yahweh shall prosper in His hand. He shall see of the travail of His soul, [and] shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My Righteous Servant justify many, for He shall bear their iniquities, Isaiah 53:10-11.

The Lamb before Whom All Will Bow and Confess

This prophecy looks back to the promise made to Adam and Eve in Genesis 3:15 after their transgression: And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; it shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel. The battle between good and evil, light and darkness, Yahweh and Satan — Yahweh would send a Savior Who was predestined to die as a Sacrificial Lamb for the sins of the world, but in death He would only spend three days and three nights in the grave, thus gaining the victory over death and the grave (Matt. 12:40; Mark 8:31).



As it required the death of a lamb to provide an atonement for Adam and Eve after their transgression, so lamb sacrifices were required for man's sin. These pointed to that Lamb (Yahshua) without blemish: But with the precious blood of Messiah, as a Lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest these last times for you, 1 Peter 1:19-20.

Isaiah wrote: Tell you, and bring [them] near, yea, let them take counsel together: who has declared from ancient time? [Who] has told it from that time? [Have] not I Yahweh? and [there is] no Elohim else beside Me; a just El and a Savior, [there is] none besides Me. Look unto Me, and be you saved, all the ends of the earth: for I [Am] El, and [there is] none else. I have sworn by Myself, the Word is gone out of My mouth [in] righteousness, and shall not return, that unto Me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear, Isaiah 45:21-23.

Here again, we find the same attributes ascribed to Yahweh as to Yahshua with the words of Philippians 2:9-11: Wherefore Yahweh also has highly exalted Him, and given Him a Name which is above every name: that at the Name of Yahshua every knee shall bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth; and [that] every tongue should confess that Yahshua Messiah is Master, to the glory of Yah the Father.

Yahshua declared that He and the Father are One (John 10:30) and agrees with the declaration of Deuteronomy 6:4, which says, Hear O Israel, Yahweh our Elohim is Yahweh, One. To understand the Oneness of Yahweh with Yahshua, we read in Genesis 1:26, Let Us make man in Our image, after Our likeness. "Elohim," "Us," "Our" — plural words, and indicating that Yahshua was with the Father Creator, at the beginning. Read our In-Depth study, *Did the Savior Pre-exist?*

This Yahshua, Whom Yahweh sent into the world which He had loved from the beginning and to which, He gave His Only-begotten Son — not to condemn the world, but that the world through Him...whoever would believe on Him should not perish, but have everlasting life (John 3:16-17).

It is He, Who was oppressed and afflicted, and as a sheep before its shearers is dumb, He opened not His mouth, but was as a Lamb brought to the slaughter. He was taken and cut off out of the land of the living.

And Who shall declare Him, Who, for the transgression of many, was stricken? (Isa. 53:7-8).

Conclusion

The Word of Yahweh which when spoken created all things, both in the heavens above and the earth beneath — This is none other, than Yahshua the Messiah, Yahweh's Only-begotten Son, sent for man's redemption. This is the Lamb spoken of in Revelation 5:12, and, yes, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory and blessing.

He, indeed, is worthy of all acclamation, and it is to Him that every knee shall bow! Will you humble yourself before Him, or stand with those in rebellion whose end will be death?

New Bible Approved from the NASB

Advanced by well known Pastor John MacArthur and others, a new translation based upon the NASB is being presented with Yahweh's Name in the Old Testament.

An article touching upon the evangel of Mark in the *Legacy Standard Bible* (LSB), already released, noted the following objections by those on the Internet promoting various pronunciations and spellings of the Father's Name:

Various Internet comments have objected to the use of "Yahweh" not because of a lack of reverence but because such commenters find the rendition to be inaccurate. The LSB preface argues:

"The translation "Yahweh" is substantiated by scholarly reconstruction as well as by historical discussions in Theodoret, Epiphanius, Clement of Alexandria, Origen, and Aquila. Consequently, those latter individuals affirm the usage of [Elohim]'s covenant name in the period of the early church."

With respect to the Hebrew textual basis, the preface writes somewhat cryptically:

"The Legacy Standard Bible utilizes the latest edition of Rudolf Kittel's Biblia Hebraica together with the most recent light from lexicography, cognate languages, and the Dead Sea Scrolls." This is strange because the newest edition, Biblica Hebraica Quinta, remains an ongoing project, whereas the most recent completely published edition is Biblica Hebraica Stuttgartensia. One assumes the translators will use the latest portions ("fascicles") available as they continue the OT translation work.

Entire article posted on thingsabove.us, called, *Legacy Standard Bible Gospel of Mark: Initial Observations*, November 20, 2020 by Garrett O'Hara.

Speaking of the newest manuscripts and archeological finds, which can help give clarification with Biblical studies, besides updating the Script itself, a few newly discovered Dead Sea Scroll fragments from Zechariah (8:16-17) and Nahum (1:5-6) were recently discovered. What is unusual, is they are written in Ancient Greek. When we think of the Dead Seas Scrolls, we think of them being written in the Hebrew language. Well, so as not to disappoint, the Ancient Greek fragments specifically show Paleo Hebrew when Yahweh's Name was written. This adds further evidence for what is written in the preface in the new LSB.





Abib Confirmed Last Month

In the month of February of this year, a few people claimed Abib, even showing a video of barley they found in Israel. They believed only a wave sheaf was needed to declare a new year.

Prior to this last new moon of March 14th, in America, we saw a report stating there are considerable amounts of Abib stage wild barley in at least two areas of Israel, with another area extremely close to being fully Abib. Another report came in from different areas, but not nearly as much was confirmed to be in an Abib state. Yet another report pointed out there were over 20-days before the wave sheaf would be presented, according to the law, in which fields will at that time be "begging to be harvested."

While we would like to have seen more fields, in general, being in a state of Abib — after some discussion, and given, albeit, limited evidence — we had confirmed the new year with the new moon of March.

Historically, it should also be noted, we have never seen Unleavened Bread in the month of May.
