# Elder in Mozambique

Again, with the help of Elders Robert Davis and Peter Mumira, more outreach was done in Africa. This time a meeting was held in Uganda towards the end of May, in which leaders from nearby provinces with their own assemblies came, were baptized into Yahshua's Name and anointed elders into the body of Messiah. One of those individuals was Elder M'mbongya Mkasa. Elder Mkasa this last month wrote to us saying: "The Assembly is recognized in the area we are serving, but they told us to register the Assembly with the government at the capital. I have done an evangelical trip from Nampula to Zimbabwe where I met five families who converted as members of Yahweh's Assembly in Yahshua and are willing to build up the body of Messiah. I only had a government pass for two weeks. They are in need of someone permanently to teach and minister the flock of YAHWEH in that place. I also gave Elder Lionel Gets of South Africa my trip feedback. We are also in need of Bibles in Swahili, Portuguese and English within Holy Names."

The Burmese population of about 40,0000 in the state of Indiana is the largest per capita in the United States. On the Sabbath of November 17th, Elder David Brett and his wife Carrie were able to meet with a number of the families who live in the Indianapolis area. The image below is about 4/5ths of those met with.

A Sabbath message, along with a question and answer session, was translated into the Burmese language by Brother Isaac Mung. Various things were addressed, speaking of the coming Kingdom, and the life of that Kingdom being lived now. The importance of the Father's Name, the Son's Name, overall obedience to the laws of Yahweh, being salvational issues, were addressed. The expression of true love for Yahweh and our

fellow man, were also presented.

The traditional Burmese food was delicious. Great job ladies!



The Spirit of Yahweh is upon Me, because He hath anointed Me to preach ...the opening of the prison to them that are bound, Luke 4:18; Isaiah 61:1.

Several readings under the words, prison and prisoner in *Strong's Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible*, provide the following phrases:

"Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise Thy Name" (Psa. 142:7); "For out of prison he cometh to reign" (Eccl. 4:14); "Turn you to the Strong Hold, ye prisoners of Hope" (Zech. 9:12); "I was in prison and Ye came unto me" (Matt. 25:36); "... and a Light shined in the prison" (Acts 12:7); "... preached unto the spirits in prison" (1 Pet. 3:19).

While exeges and commentary help to explain the meanings of these words in their context, a meditation upon them conjures thoughts of a man yielded to, overcome by, and brought into bondage (imprisoned), to the lusts of his flesh (sin). But with the Goodness of Yahweh (Light) having come, to bring his soul out of prison. To lead him to repentance (2 Pet. 2:19; Rom. 2:2).

Yes, His Word, the Light of the Glorious Evangel, transcends a man's soul imprisoned to the affections of his flesh, into a prisoner of Hope – who wouldn't have greater cause to turn to the Strong Hold and praise His Name (1 Tim. 1:11)?
