The Calendar and Human Life



Yahweh's annual calendar, in correlation with the formation of Human life, is significant. Consider the Biblical timetable of appointed times and the gestation of a human baby from conception to birth:

PASSOVER

In the woman's monthly cycle on the fourteenth day the egg appears, which must be

fertilized within 24 hours, or it will be passed on. Yahshua's death gave Life.

DAYS OF UNLEAVENED BREAD

Within two to six days the egg attaches itself to the wall of the womb. Within the Days of Unleavened Bread it will feed on the pure food from the mother.

FEAST OF WEEKS (Pentecost)

By the fiftieth day an embryo shows arms, hands, fingers, legs, feet, head and eyes. The full form of a human being has developed.

FEAST OF TRUMPETS

The beginning of the seventh month the fetus can hear and distinguish sounds outside the womb.

ATONEMENT

On the tenth day of the seventh month the hemoglobin of the blood changes from mother to the baby's self-sustaining circulation.

FEAST OF TABERNACLES


On the fifteenth day of the seventh month the lungs become fully developed. If born before then the baby would have extremely hard time breathing.

THE EIGHTH DAY (Last Great Day)

Birth takes place on the tenth day of the ninth month. Eight days after birth a son is circumcised, equivalent to the nation of Judah's Feast of Hanukkah (nine months and ten days after Passover).



I Believe in Tithing!

Q. Can I use my tithe for charities and to help my needy neighbor?

A. The tithe is holy to Yahweh. The tithe is to be used to glorify Him by helping proclaim the evangel to expand His kingdom. As new converts are added to Yahweh's truth, His Spirit indwells more people: *Know you not that you are the Temple of Yahweh, and* [that] *the Spirit of Yahweh dwells in you?* 1 Corinthians 3:16.

When something is holy to Yahweh, we must be careful how we handle it. We can always find the poor, who for one reason or another can use our help, and like Paul we could bestow all our goods on the poor (1 Cor. 13:3). However, Yahshua said we would always have the poor with us (Matt. 26:11). We are expected to do good to all people, but especially to those of the true faith (Gal. 6:10). This often means some sacrifice on our part in being faithful to Yahweh.



Yahweh's Assembly in Yahshua

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Yahweh provides for the needy through the third tithe (Deut. 14:28-29). This is not the first or regular tithe. We are commanded to deliver the first tithe to the treasure house (Neh. 10:38-39), which is put in the charge of certain ones to handle (Neh. 12:44; 13:11-12). Hebrews 7:5 says the Levites, the priests, were to take the tithe (reference to Num. 18:22 -26). A special chamber was set aside for the tithe (2 Chron. 31:11-12). In Malachi 3:10 He says, *Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there might be meat in Mine house*. We are to take care of Yahweh's work first and foremost. If Yahweh's people do not do their share in proclaiming the Good News, who else will?

Our Spiritual Death and Life

Our birth can be a joy and a blessing from Yahweh. Were we ever told to, or is it implied, that we should celebrate the day of our birth? Of course not. If we entertain the idea of these traditions being acceptable then we must look deeper into Scripture. Verses that come to mind, when speaking of such traditions, are as follows:

And He said to them, "Well did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites," as it is written, "This people honors Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me; in vain do they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the precepts of men.' You leave the commandment of Yahweh, and hold fast the tradition of men." And He said to them, "You have a fine way of rejecting the commandment of Yahweh, in order to keep your tradition!" Mark 7:6-9 RSV.

Although these verses aren't specifically about birthday celebrations, we definitely see how Yahshua felt about non-Biblical tradition. The Scriptures support the knowledge of our spiritual birth being much more meaningful than our physical birth. Dying to our sinful nature and having the opportunity of life-everlasting through the Messiah and baptism is what's important.
