What to Believe?

Today, there is much commentary – of the "making of many books there is no end" (Eccl. 12:12) – and exposition of the Word proceeding from pulpits – "For though ye have ten thousand instructors in Messiah, yet have ye not many fathers …" (1 Cor. 4:15) – so that a people, both readers and hearers, find themselves tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of diverse and strange doctrine (Eph. 4:14; Heb. 13:9).

Who is right? Who is wrong? Who, to believe? Who, not to believe?

These are questions that beg answers and particularly, as one studies to show himself approved unto Yahweh as a workman aspiring to rightly divide and speak the Truth (2 Tim. 2:15) as an Oracle (1 Pet. 4:11), and to present himself before the Chief Shepherd (1 Pet. 5:4) and Overseer (1 Pet. 2:25)



without shame, having the answer of a good conscience (1 Pet. 3:21) and void of offense toward Yah and toward men (Acts 24:16).

Institutions of religion (denominations) are created by blind guides (Matt. 23: 24) thinking themselves somewhat in conference (Gal. 2:6) but neither understanding

what they say nor affirm (1 Tim. 1:7) but yet, ever so skillful in making to themselves proselytes (Matt. 23:15) but then afterward, shutting up the Kingdom of Yahweh against them and neither entering in themselves (Matt. 23:13).

Unskillful in the Word of Righteousness, their senses neither exercised to discern (Heb. 5:13-14) truth from error (1 John 4:6), they with smooth (Isa. 30:10) and feigned (2 Pet. 2:3) fair speeches (Rom. 16:18) and great swelling words of vanity (2 Pet. 2:19), corrupt (2 Cor. 2:17), deceitfully handle (2 Cor. 4:2), and make private interpretations (2 Pet. 1:20) of the Word of Yahweh and deceive the hearts of the simple (Rom. 16:18).


Of a truth, men can believe a lie and therewith be damned (2 Thess. 2:11-12). But that Yahshua will hold men accountable for what they believe and for how they have believed; for what they disbelieve and why they have disbelieved, is understood.

Men need not be ignorant, however. They can receive to themselves a love of the Truth that they might be saved (2 Thess. 2:10). Men need not be igno-

rant. But they which are willingly so (2 Pet. 3:5) are also, the most vulnerable to becoming deceived. Men need not be ignorant, that the adversary is come to change the affirmation, from "Yah hath said" (Gen. 3:3) to incertitude, "Yea, hath Yah said?" (Gen. 3:1).

Indeed, that Righteous Judge (Yahshua) will, on that great and notable day (Acts 2:20), of believers of every persuasion and nomenclature – and of nonbelievers of no persuasion or nomenclature – query of all as they stand before His bar of Judgment, "Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or did others tell it thee of Me?" (John 18:34).

And at that time, one must already have searched out "the Matter" – as the honor of kings, is so to do – what Yahweh has concealed (Prov. 25:2) and proved all things (1 Thess. 5:21) that he might, having done all to stand, to stand therefore (Eph. 6:13, 14) ... fully persuaded in his own mind (Rom. 14:5), that believing a lie might have been good enough to have lived for, as he wasted the substance of life (Luke 15:13) making provision for the affections and lusts of his flesh (Rom. 13:14) and running to an excess of riot (1 Pet. 4:4) and revelry (Gal. 5:21), but believing a lie will have been scarcely good enough to die for!



And so, "What to believe, and what not to believe": That is the question. Well, He is not willing that any should be ignorant (Rom. 1:13, 11:25; 1 Cor. 10:1, 12:1; 2 Cor. 1:8; 1 Thess. 4:12), but that all should get to themselves understanding (Prov. 4:7), comprehend and apprehend what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height of His fullness (Eph. 3:18-19; Phil. 3:12) and conclude therefore, there is but one way that "Ye shall KNOW the Truth: Search the Scriptures" (John 8:32, 5:39).

Due to the pandemic of COVID-19, federal, state and county guidelines may change by the time we are ready to attend the Feast of Tabernacles this fall. If the campground cannot host us, due to these or other circumstances, we will as a backup, plan to hold all services at the assembly building itself at Kingdom City. We believe that there will not be further lockdowns, but please be aware, temporary housing would change (as well as individual costs) due to only local motels/hotels being nearby. If necessary, some recreational RVs can be parked at the assembly building



with showers and bathrooms being available on site. Tents may also be an option, but please note that fall can be a very rainy time in Missouri. We will keep everyone posted as we learn more information.

Alms Missionary Support Fund

As we reach out here in this country and overseas, there will inevitably be those with spiritual needs as well as physical. We realize that the spiritual needs have been met for the most part, while the requests for physical help has gone mostly unanswered. We have tried to make sure that the first tithe and offerings coming in, go to providing for the spiritual food and growth for the body of Messiah. See our booklet, The Temple Tenth. We also teach that the second tithe is for each individual to be able to keep the Feasts. See our ministudy, Yahweh's Appointed Feast Days: Now YOU Can Afford to Attend. The third tithe, however, has never really been emphasized. This is mainly due to the taxation we have in this country, which can



be up to 30%, some going directly to help widows, orphans, the poor, etc., via government subsidies. With that said, not all countries have a good foundation of support for their poor and needy. We also have a desire, if Yahweh is willing, to travel to some of the areas both in which there are assemblies and areas in which assemblies need to be established.

Therefore, we have opened a separate account for this fund. If you would like to help the poor and were wondering how you might go about it, consider taking a third tithe principle and applying it here.

Any funds designated for this account, should be noted and made out to "YAIY Alms Missionary Support".


