In the winter of 2009, a large passenger plane made an emergency landing in New York's Hudson River.

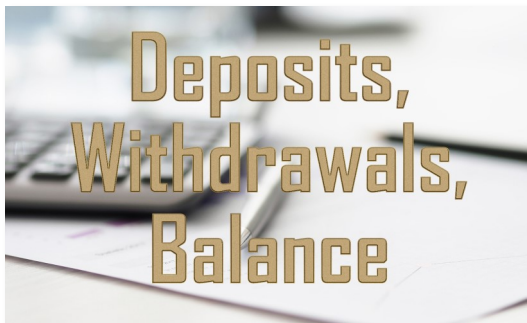
The pilot, Captain Chesley Sullenberger, who landed the plane safely with no casualties, was later asked about those moments in the air when he was faced with a life-and-death decision.

Who, in behalf of all, paid a debt He did not owe and extends to all, a generous credit line of mercy and grace without the need for overdraft protection.

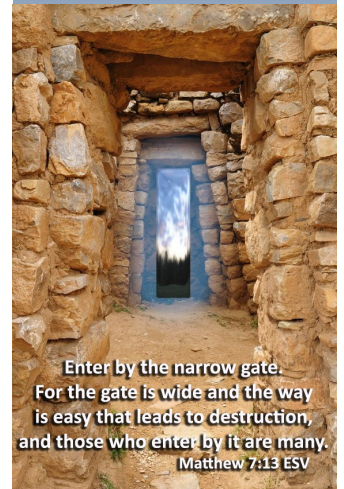

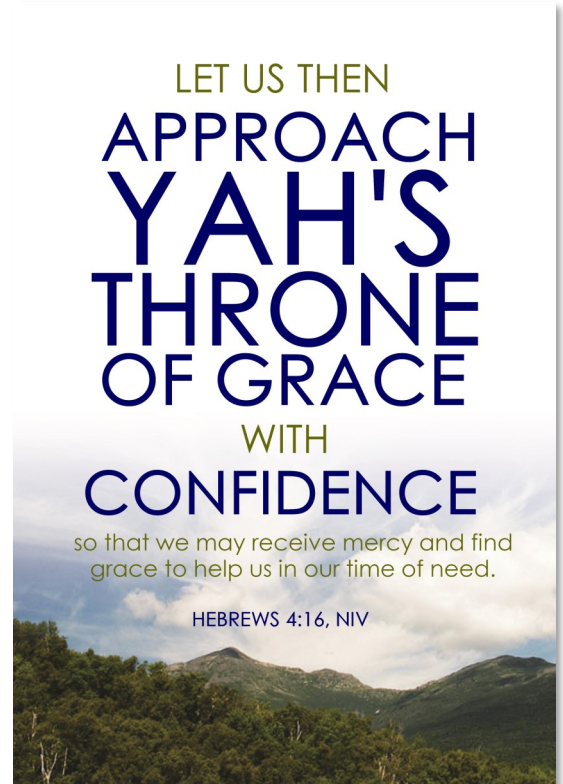
To the speaker – as one often spoken to – and to another, as one spoken to, here are *5 Ways To Show You're Listening*:

## Teens for Yah Website

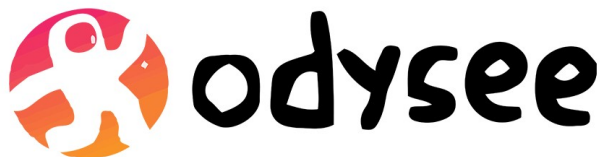

## USA Feast of Tabernacles 2021
