Becoming Spiritually Mature

When we began our life on this earth we were completely dependent upon others for survival. Every one of us started as infants and relied fully upon our mother for food and care during those first few years. As we developed and grew we became more self-reliant. It is always a thrill for parents to see their children make the transition from crawling to taking their first steps alone. The children are now well on the way toward independence.

This sign of maturity is followed by other advances in the maturation process, which continue through adolescence and even beyond. Making our own decisions and pursuing life's goals does not come quickly enough at times for impatient youth. To be independent and self-sufficient is a natural desire.



Physical and emotional growth are one thing, but spiritual maturity is another matter. Spiritual growth takes its own course in its own time. Spiritual maturity is more or less dependent upon exposure to the Bible and its message, either directly or through human intervention. The Bible shows that spiritual maturity is the purpose for our being born

The writer of Hebrews encourages us to grow in grace and knowledge and become grown-up, responsible people: Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Messiah, let us go on unto perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward Yahweh, Hebrews 6:1. We are expected to elevate our thinking, our concepts, our understanding, and our attitudes.

As we grow spiritually we automatically move away from the lusts of the flesh and the worldly desires common to the natural man. The spiritual person thinks differently from the unconverted individual. He or she seeks to meet the challenges of the higher spiritual plane imposed by Almighty Yahweh.


This is what Yahshua had in mind when He gave His disciples an example of spiritual discernment of truth. They were preoccupied with worldly, mundane, temporal thoughts that would eventually pass away. He plainly told them: *It is the Spirit that quickens; the flesh profits nothing: the words that I speak unto you,* [they] *are Spirit, and* [they] *are life,* John 6:63.

Growing in grace and knowledge through a better understanding of the Bible and Yahweh's will for our lives directly affects spiritual progress. We become more like the Savior. To help us achieve this goal of a higher outlook through His Spirit, Yahshua "gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers" (Eph. 4:11).

These positions are necessary to the growing body of believers. We are not to forget the assembling of ourselves together whenever possible (Heb. 10:25). Through fellowship we are exposed to the good influences of the brethren. Being

together with others who also strive for deeper spiritual growth will help bathe our thoughts for a time in righteous values and much needed virtue.

This exposure is essential. Regular weekly fellowship relieves us from the constant pressures of the mundane world forces upon us during the week and refocuses our spiritual commitment to Yahweh.

Paul says the leaders of the Assembly were given "for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Messiah" (Eph. 4:12). Each of us is given a job to do. We are expected to grow and mature in the Savior, and in turn build up and edify the body of Messiah ourselves. Our task is to help make the Body of believers strong in the faith and mature in the teachings of the Savior, becoming a perfect man. As Paul wrote us: *Till we all come in the unity of faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of Yahweh, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Messiah*, Ephesians 4:13.

Those who are mature in the Messiah are expected to reflect adult behavior. That is, they no longer are dependent upon others to carry them along in the faith. Rather, as mature believers we pay our own way and take it upon ourselves to do our share, not using others to our advantage.

The spiritually grown up recognize the great benefit they derive from the studies and explanations done by others that help us all comprehend the true message of salvation.

Yahweh has given some individuals gifts for explaining what the Bible teaches through lessons that are easily understood. We should be mature enough to acknowledge their efforts and be supportive.

Instead of freely taking advantage of their labors, it behooves those who strive for spiritual maturity to pay their way and "owe no man anything." There are many who do nothing more than gather whatever "freebies" may be available, thus causing others to provide the means by which they are fed. This is not spiritual maturity, but the way of the spiritual adolescent — the natural man.

One of the tests we face in life is to determine our willingness to pay a price for our salvation. Yahshua has already provided the salvation, which is free to all. But each of us will be tested to see whether we are sincere and willing to stand fast in spite of adversity and trials. Our Savior was goodness personified. His whole life was devoted to giving to others. How sincere is the follower of Yahshua who is here only to take whatever he can get at the expense of other believers?

Those who have but little strength but who know and understand the Name of the Heavenly Father and His Son have a special place in Yahshua's heart. These have obeyed and kept His Word and did not deny His Name. They were not strong or famous, but were diligent and obedient, and when it came to the Sacred Name, they did not deny, refuse, turn down, withhold, disapprove, disallow, contradict, dispute, controvert, disaffirm, repudiate, disown, disclaim, or disavow His holy Name.

Notice what our Savior told John to write: I know your works; behold, I have set before you an open door, and no man can shut it: for you have a little strength, and have kept My word, and have not denied My Name, Revelation 3:8.

In being willing to stand fast in the truth each day in spite of inconveniences or even an occasional sacrifice, we will be worthy to stand before the Son of man when He returns. The person who sacrifices himself to help others will not be required to go through the worst of the great trials and tribulations that are coming on this earth.

Our Savior promises this as He continues with those who have not denied His Name. Because you have kept the word of My patience. I will also keep you from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth, Revelation 3:10.

Yahweh's Assembly in Yahshua teaches and abides by the tithing system given us in the Bible. It is the fairest of all, for ten percent of one's income is what Yahweh expects from His people. He promises that those who tithe to Him will be blessed, and His Name and His way of life will be proclaimed around the world.

To be fully mature in the Messiah means not only that we pay our own way, but that we also seek to help others, especially babes in the Word. Become a strengthener for those in need. Don't take, as the world does, but give in every manner in which He has given to you.

The spiritually mature do whatever they can to build up the body of Messiah and help the brethren grow. What we do to the assembly of believers we do to Yahshua Himself (Matt. 24:40). If we take from Yahshua.

To whom Yahweh has given much, much is required. To paraphrase our former President Kennedy's observation, "Ask not what the body of Messiah can do for you. Rather, ask what you can do to edify and build up the body of Messiah."
