and committed acts contrary to Yahweh's laws. Yahweh's Word demands obedience. When sin enters the picture sacrificial blood must be shed. A life for breaking His law.

Trumpets New Moon

New moons are designated to establish biblical months. While new moons do establish the seven annual Feasts, they do not establish the weekly pattern, nor the seventh day Sabbath. The new moons also do not establish the sabbatical year pattern of seven for agricultural crops. This year's biblical seventh month (for the North American Region land mass) began with the sighting of the new moon on the evening of 09-28-11. It confirmed our calculations for the Feast of Trumpets (09-29-11). See the YAIY calendar for 2011.



"Originally, the New Moon was not fixed by astronomical calculations, but was solemnly proclaimed after witnesses had testified to the reappearance of the crescent of the moon. On the 30th of each month, the members of the High Court assembled in a courtyard in Jerusalem, named Beit Ya'azek, where they waited to receive the testimony of two reliable witnesses; they then sanctified the New Moon."

We build Spiritual muscle. "...solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil," Hebrews 5:14.



We become joyful when we overcome certain trials. "As an example, brethren, of suffering and patience, take the prophets who spoke in the name of Yahweh. 11 We count those blessed who endured. You have heard of the endurance of Job and have seen the outcome of Yahweh's dealings, that Yahweh is full of compassion and is merciful," James 5:10–11.

Aaronic or Levitical Priests?

Aaron's sons were technically the priests we find in Numbers 3:10 "So you shall appoint Aaron and his sons that they may keep their priesthood, but the layman who comes near shall be put to death." And there are distinctions noted between priests and Levites in certain areas of Scripture like 1 Chronicles 23:1–2 "Now when David reached old age, he made his son Solomon king over Israel. 2 And he gathered together all the leaders of Israel with the priests and the Levites."

Here, though, we find Levi designated as priests. Deuteronomy 18:1–2 "The Levitical priests, the whole tribe of Levi, shall have no portion or inheritance with Israel; they shall eat Yahweh's offerings by fire and His portion. 2 They shall have no inheritance among their countrymen; Yahweh is their inheritance, as He promised them."

While there is some question as to why the Levites are referred to as a priesthood, it is found in the fact that Aaron was a Levite. Exodus 4:12–14 "Now then go, and I, even I, will be with your mouth, and teach you what you are to say.' 13 But he said, 'Please, Master, now send the message by whomever You will.' 14 Then the anger of Yahweh burned against Moses, and He said, 'Is there not your brother Aaron the Levite? I know that he speaks fluently. And moreover, behold, he is coming out to meet you; when he sees you, he will be glad in his heart.'"

In the coming Kingdom we find prophecy, through the vision of Ezekiel of a new physical temple in the promised land. Though Levi and the rest of Israel went astray, Yahweh will bring them into the kingdom as a physical people. The Levites in particular will be doing blood sacrifices for the physical people. Ezekiel 44:10–11 "But the Levites who went far from Me when Israel went astray, who went astray from Me after their idols, shall bear the punishment for their iniquity. Yet they shall be ministers in My sanctuary, having oversight at the gates of the house and ministering in the house; they shall slaughter the burnt offering and the sacrifice for the people, and they shall stand before them to minister to them."
