Blessings Come With Sharing Truth

Many believers in Yahshua the Messiah think that spreading the word by radio, television, internet or printed page is the best way to convert the world. This outreach does have advantages in making the public aware of the deeper truths of the Bible.

Our efforts include revealing the perversion of many teachings that hinder the average person from discovering the truth of Yahweh's Word. We make every effort to follow Jeremiah 10, "Learn not the way of the heathen." Yahweh says don't take up pagan ways and days of worship and adapt them in some way to worship Him, the true Creator of the universe.

But there is an even more effective way to witness to others that each of us can do.

Famous evangelist Dr. Charles G. Trumbell, who had preached to great congregations for 20 years, was a writer and editor of a weekly religious paper that reached a circulation of 100,000, and was the author of 30 books. Yet in spite of all his prolific efforts in literature and speaking, he said that he had won more people to the truth of Messiah in private conversation than in sermons or in print. Others have said the same thing.



While public expounding and speaking of the Word has its place, the conversation of a person is mainly done through explaining the truth of the Bible to willing ears. Effective preaching can explain Scripture and motivate one to action, but it is the one-on-one interaction that solidifies faith of the believer.

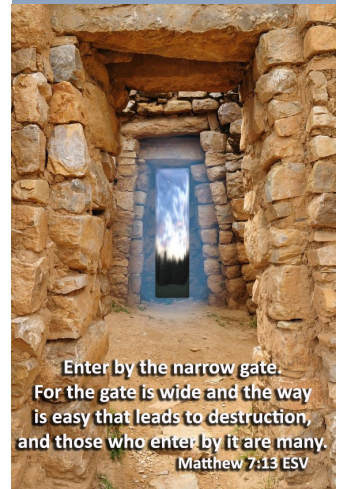
Converting others does not require worldly wisdom of or the gift of eloquent speech. Nor does it take special training. It takes one who is himself or herself convicted and guided by Yahweh's Spirit.

The hearts of inquirers can be reached in the lunch room, at services, at the rest stop, over coffee, driving in a car, in a hospital, a jail or whatever one can talk openly with others. With some, much time will be needed to get answers to all the questions. Patience and persistence will be required by some because deeper truth often must penetrate a mind already well saturated in false concepts and worldly customs.

Personal evangelism is a sacrifice. A woman once said to an evangelist,

Give no offense to Jews or to Greeks or to the Assembly of Elohim, just as I try to please everyone in everything I do, not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved.

1 Corinthians 10:32-33 ESV



Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. Matthew 7:13 ESV

“Oh I would give the world if I could win souls as you do.” “That is what it cost me,” was his response.

Converting others to Yahweh’s truth costs time, work, sacrifice, faith, and determination to be a tool for Yahweh’s truth. It cannot be done without a deeper knowledge of the Bible and guidance by the Holy Spirit.

Yahshua explained to Peter that the assembly would be built upon Peter’s confession that Yahshua was the Rock. Yahshua then promised Peter the keys to the Kingdom: *I will give unto you the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever you shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever you shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven*, Matthew 16:19. John 10:7 reveals that Yahshua is the Door. We are to guide others to the “Door” of the sheep. The body of believers, the “called-out ones,” are to reach out to others with the truth Yahweh has revealed to them. We are to go and teach all nations (Matt. 28:19-20).

This does not mean we are only to stand and preach a rousing sermon. There are other ways we can convince our neighbors, associates, and those we meet. We are to be a living epistle of Messiah by acting out Yahweh’s laws and making them come to life by what we say and do in our everyday activities.

Forasmuch as you are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Messiah ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living Elohim: not in tables of stone, but in fleshly tables of the heart, 2 Corinthians 3:3.

Instead of reading or hearing about Yahweh’s way of life, those with whom, we come in contact can see in our lives a living example of Yahweh’s laws at work. We are to be examples of overcomers who represent Yahweh’s new and living way (Jer. 31:31).

The monks and nuns who spent their days only in prayer and self-affliction were far from Yahweh’s heart and plans. The preacher who preaches to crowds and lives in pleasant palaces with the very rich is not in accord with Yahweh’s will. Personal witnessing with modest living effectively furthers truth.

The real joy does not stop with our baptism into Yahshua’s saving Name. It finds the greatest expression in helping guide someone to the Savior. Then we have the joy of Yahweh’s favor, the gratitude of those who now seek baptism, and the inner warmth of Yahweh’s Spirit.

By our regular tithes we help those proclaiming the message of salvation by literature, CD’s, DVD’s, and preaching as we seek to be a vessel of truth, making the Bible come alive by our example and joyful demeanor. The blessings of our sacrifices will follow.

And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament: and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever, Daniel 12:3.

Question and Answer

Q. How do we handle conversations with others who believe differently than us and claim "G-d" speaks to their heart?

A. It's very common in Christianity for people to say, "the L-rd told me ..." this and such. Ultimately, if they are not honoring the Sabbaths of Yahweh (Isa. 58:13), then we can pretty much assume that they're speaking falsely (1 John 2:4). However, who is to say that Yahweh is not leading them to the truth? (2 Tim. 1:9-10).

Most of us have believed lies in the past, but here we are. Acceptance doesn't mean we approve or even agree with others (1 Cor. 5:13). However, accepting others often leads to trust (Rom. 12:18; Heb. 12:14), which then allows others to hear what we have to say. It is said that "time is the ally of deceit"; however, time is also the ally of long-suffering, mercy, understanding and forgiveness. This is, we believe, the essence of loving your enemy (Matt. 5:43).

The Feast of Tabernacles will be from the 14th to the 20th, with the Eight Day on the 21st.
