Covid-19 and the Feast

COVID'S Impact upon the Feast of Tabernacles

We had been notified by the trustees of Woodland Hills, our contracted St. Clair, Missouri, Feast Site, that our arrangement with them had been canceled due to the increase in confirmed cases of the coronavirus in their county.

We already had an alternative plan in place in that event, to convene on the Assembly grounds. Contact us for motel/hotel or RV information. Precluding another stay-at-home/lockdown order imposed by the Governor, we intend to move forward with our alternative plan. However, because COVID continues to surge in numbers, we are imposing stringent protocols to assure the health safety of attendees at the Feast.

- Random/daily temperature checks will be conducted on every attendee, and if an individual's temperature is 101° or above, or if, in the past 48 hours, the individual has presented with any of the following symptoms: headache, sweating accompanying fever, dry cough, hoarseness, arrhythmic respiratory distress, or fatigue, admittance onto the premises will be denied and the attendee will be advised to seek testing either to confirm positivity or negativity and if positive, will quarantine off premises.
- As much as it is practicable, social distancing will be observed and enforced by the leadership of elders. And whenever social distancing is not possible, attendees <u>must</u> wear face coverings. Therefore, each attendee should bring an acceptable face covering that covers both the nose and the mouth.
- The first preventive measure for the spread of any disease is vigorous handwashing. Aseptic handwashing protocols are placed at every sink, and <u>must</u> be employed after toileting and before handling/serving food.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided by the Assembly. Nevertheless we recommend each attendee come with a personal supply, as hand sanitizer, like so many other commodities, are in short supply. **Frequent** use of hand sanitizer is advisable, and particularly after touching common articles, like drawer pulls, door knobs, light switches, serving utensils and condiments (including salt and pepper shakers) before eating and it is suggested, therefore, that each attendee carry a personal pocket/purse bottle of hand sanitizer for that purpose.
- Other directives may be prescribed, as situations occur.



Please know, it is not at all, the intention of the leadership of elders to be overbearing on these points but it is our purpose, to assure that all present have as an enjoyable and safe Feast that we, as laborers together with Yahweh, can provide. Your understanding is appreciated, and your attendance at this year's Feast of Tabernacles implies your cooperation.

Lastly, the leadership will do nothing without having the injunction of Scripture as its authority.
