

What is a Prophet?

A prophet is a special messenger of Yahweh. Prophets are people that Yahweh reveals His future plans to. The prophet then announces those plans to the people. There are numerous prophecies in the Bible, and most of them are still not fulfilled! Indeed, entire books in the Bible are devoted to prophecy such as the book of Isaiah. Some prophecies are very good and foretell happy endings. But others foretell calamity and destruction. Yahweh used some prophecies to warn His people to change their ways before disaster struck.

Here is a list of the books that mainly focus on prophecy in the Bible: Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi, and Revelation.



A prophet's life was sometimes very difficult. Sometimes they would be killed by the people that they declared Yahweh's judgment against. Most were ignored and ridiculed. Loneliness and isolation were common with the prophets. Sadness and despair were also common. In fact, Jeremiah has been known as the "weeping prophet" because he was so sad about what would happen to the people if they did not repent and obey Yahweh.

No, a prophet's life was never easy. But we can be thankful that their words from Yahweh were written down for our benefit, so that we can know what Yahweh expects of all of us.




Help the Prophet Jonah reach the city of Nineveh so he can warn the people of Yahweh's coming wrath for their sinfulness.


