I was sitting and talking with two other children. We watched as an elderly man was walking past the school across the street. I was a sensitive and tender-natured child, and was shocked and upset to see some of the student taunting the old man, and calling him terrible names. It impacted me so severely that I still remember it very clearly even now 30 years later! It reminds me that the Bible tells us we are to respect our elders. 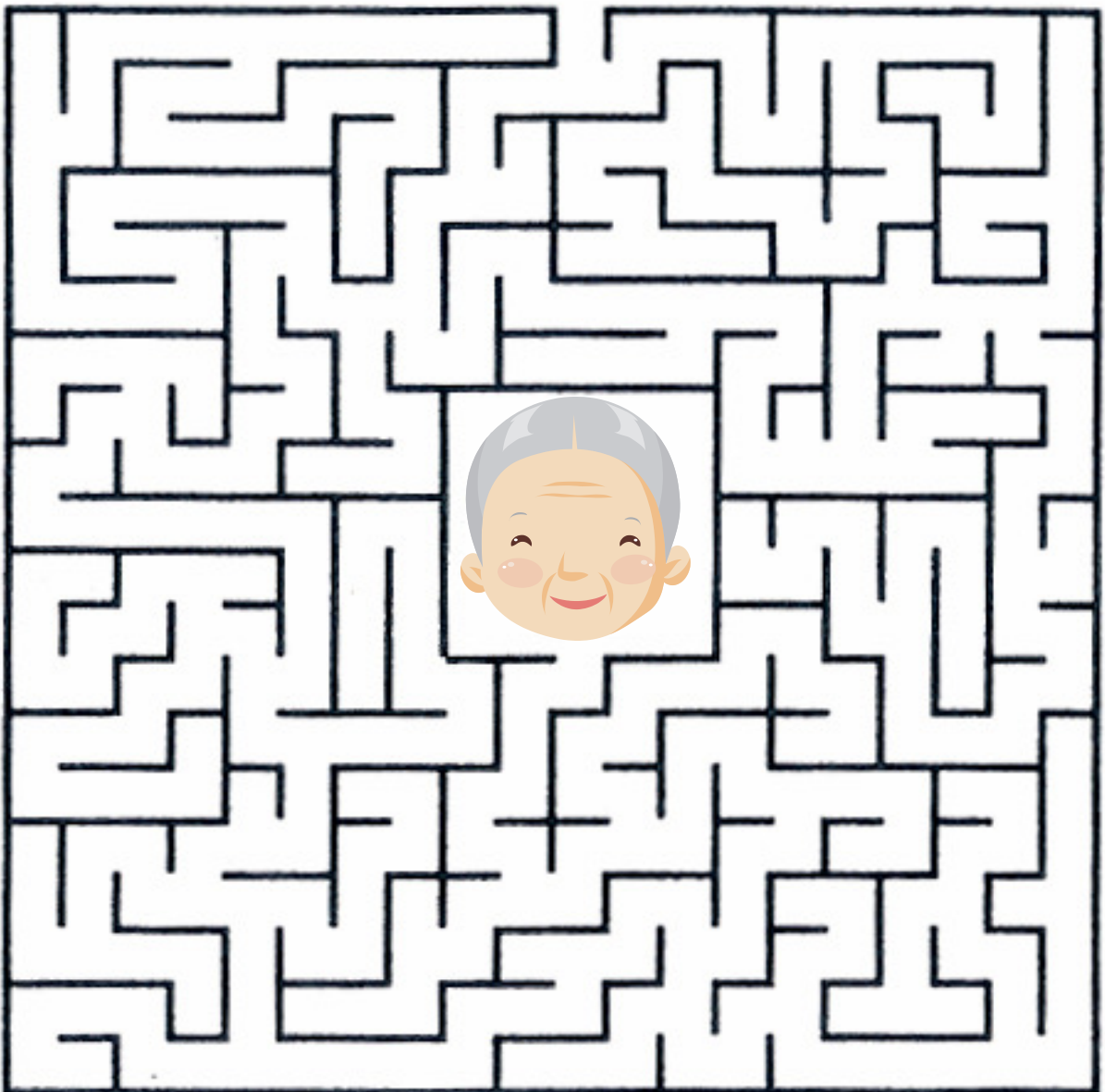
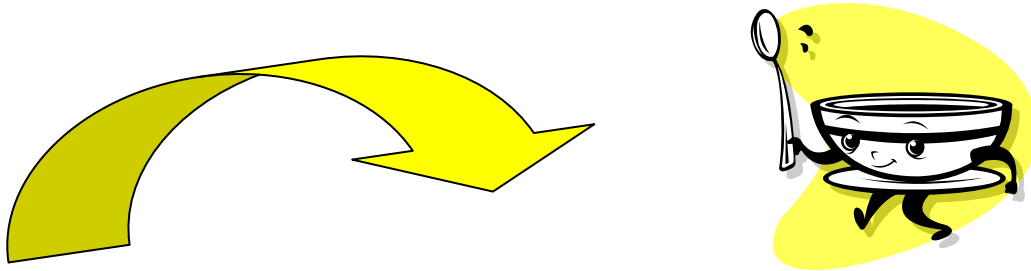
