In time, everyone started getting hungry. The disciples requested that Yahshua send the people away. But Yahshua said, "They don't need to go away. You feed them." The disciples began to argue, "We only have five loaves of bread and two fish!" Then an incredible miracle took place. Yahshua looked up to heaven and gave thanks and the food was multiplied to feed everyone! There were over five thousand people fed that day. Let us never forget that with Yahweh all things are possible.


