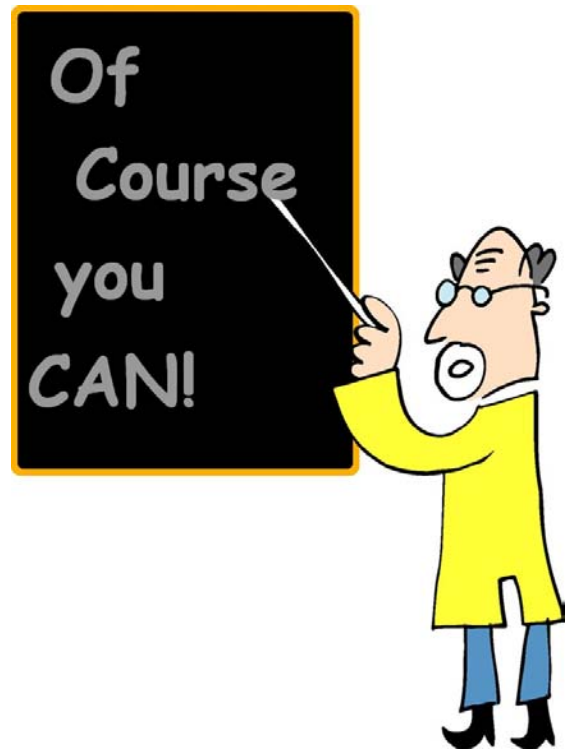

What is an altar?

An altar is a place where people would offer sacrifices to Yahweh. In the Old Testament, people simply made altars using piles of stones. They were built anywhere that people wanted to offer to Yahweh to receive a special blessing or to give thanks, including battlefields, or mountaintops. By New Testament times, when the Temple was built, the altar was made of special wood and pure gold. It was the duty of the priests to place the offerings on the altar. Today we don't sacrifice animals. We offer Yahweh songs of praise and our prayers.
