Daily life for the average Israelite

Have you ever wondered what life was like for the ancient Hebrews? Let's take a look!

- Families worked very hard together to take care of their animals and household duties.
- Families were often very large! It was not unusual for families to have 12 or more children. Imagine the sibling rivalry!
- Dwelling places were very small. Many families lived in animal-skin tents. But some lived in either mud brick or straw houses which consisted of only a few small rooms. It was guaranteed that none of the children ever had their own rooms!
- The average diet was extremely simple compared to today's diet. They did not have grocery stores with thousands of food choices. People would subsist on fruits, vegetables, nuts, grains, and small amounts of meat, fish, and dairy.
- Most children did not have access to formal schooling. They were taught by their parents.
- Male children were preferred over female children, but female children were still cherished because they played a large role in daily life. Daughters would help mom prepare food and keep the home tidy.
- Mothers did not usually work outside the home.
- War and famine were fairly common.
- Toys were very limited, but they did exist! Archaeologists have uncovered what appears to be board games, and cloth dolls for little girls, along with figurines in the shapes of animals that children may have played with. But definitely no video games, skate boards, or bicycles!
