The Pharisees were mostly made up of middle class business men and synagogue leaders. Throughout the New Testament, Yahshua continually had to deal with them and their hypocritical actions. Paul was a Pharisee, as we can read in Acts 23:6. The Pharisees were against Yahshua in every way. They caused numerous problems and tried to hinder Him.

Paul greatly persecuted the followers of Yahshua, even being responsible for some of their deaths. He was greatly feared among early converts. But, things were about to change for Paul. While riding his horse on the road to Damascus, Paul was struck down by a blinding light and a powerful Voice asking him, "Paul, Paul! Why are you persecuting me?" Paul cried out, "Who are you?" The Voice answered, "I am Yahshua, Whom you are persecuting!"

So began a complete transformation in Paul's Life. He became one of Yahshua's strongest followers. In fact, he is credited for writing many of the New Testament letters. Paul also traveled far and wide to preach the Evangel to everyone including gentiles. Paul's experience is amazing because it shows that Yahweh can transform a person completely, even if they previously did very bad things. Yahweh can forgive anyone's past, no matter how terrible it was. And for that, we can be thankful.


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## Paul said:
