Everything was fine at first, and the boat was drifting along peacefully. Yahshua fell asleep on a cushion in the stern of the boat. Suddenly a violent storm arose! It rocked the boat and water splashed on everyone. The disciples were terrified. They woke Yahshua up and said, "We're going to drown! Don't you care about us?"



But Yahshua remained very calmed and simply rebuked the storm and said, "Quiet! Be still!" The wind died down and the sea became calm again. Yahshua looked at his disciples and said, "Why did you fear? Do you still have no faith?"

The disciples were astonished and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and waves obey Him!" The disciples learned a very important lesson that



Craft Activity for Parents and Children!

IMPORTANT NOTE: Children, this activity is meant to be done with your parents! Please ask their permission before trying this.

Paper Tube Boats:

You can create a boat using old toilet paper tubes. The tubes need to be cut in half using safety Younger children will scissors. need an adult to do this for them. The children can paint and decorate their boats. If desired, a craft stick and a small piece of fabric can also be used as a mast and flag. It's up to you! Have fun with this activity! Parents, make your own boat, too, so you can demonstrate how the boat may have looked during the storm.



Next fill a bucket or shallow pan with water. Place your boat in it. Show it floating along calmly. Then mix up the water a bit so the children can see what a boat does during a storm. Splash a little to show them how water might come onto the boat and might even pull the boat under water. Explain to the children that the people on the boat were probably terrified. But there was no need to be afraid because Yahshua can calm even the worst of storms. Allow the water to settle and the boat to float calmly again.
