

Let's explore Pentecost!

While Pentecost is now past us, let's take some time to learn more about this very important Holy Day. One of the most significant events took place on a Pentecost almost two thousand years ago: The disciples received the gift of Yahweh's Set-apart Spirit. It is interesting to note that the disciples were still keeping the Holy Days after Yahshua's death. Many people say we no longer have to keep Yahweh's Feast Days, but this proves otherwise. It's a good thing that the disciples were gathered together in Jerusalem on the day of Pentecost, otherwise they would not have received the pouring out of Yahweh's Spirit as promised by Yahshua Himself! The Set-apart Spirit was also called the "Comforter."



In the Old Testament, Pentecost was known as the Feast of Weeks, Feast of Firstfruits, or Shavuot. Pentecost in the Greek means "Count 50." So what is the purpose of receiving the Set-apart Spirit? The Spirit helps us in our walk with Yahshua, and assists us in keeping Yahweh's law. It can also convict us of sin so that we may repent and change our ways.

The Spirit appeared as "tongues of fire" above the disciples heads. And they were allowed to speak in

other languages. It is believed that this was the birth of the New Testament Assembly (not "church"). The word "assembly" comes from the Greek *ekklesia*, and simply means "called out ones." Another interesting fact about Pentecost is that we are to present two leavened loaves of bread, unlike during the Feast of Unleavened Bread where we are only to eat unleavened bread.

We pray your Pentecost was blessed! May you be a blessing to Yahweh by your obedience.
