Yahweh's fall Feast season

Summer's over, and now Yahweh's people find themselves entering the fall Feast season. There are four fall Feasts that we need to be aware of. We find them in this order: Feast of Trumpets, Day of Atonement, Feast of Tabernacles, and the Eighth Day also called The Last Great Day. In this lesson, we will only take a brief look at the first two on the list.



All of the fall Feasts are set-apart to Yahweh, and we are commanded to observe them. The Feast of Trumpets is also known as Yom Teruah, and Day of Atonement is also known as Yom Kippur. One thing that is very special about the Feast of

Trumpets is it always falls on a new moon day with a full moon on the first day of the Feast of Tabernacles. The one thing that is very different about the Day of Atonement is that we are to abstain from food and water. This is called fasting. We are allowed to eat and drink liquids on all the other Feast Days.

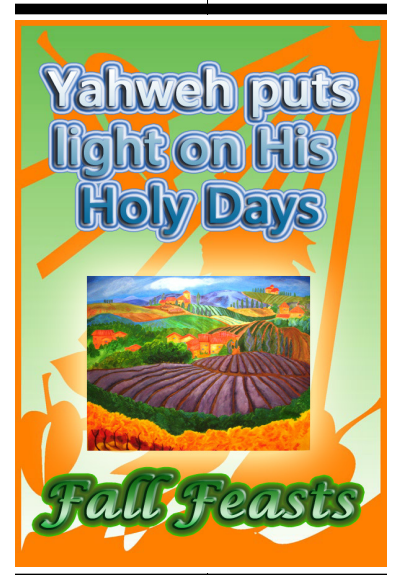


While we do not know the exact year, many believe that Yahshua Messiah will return on a Holy Feast Day, possibly the Feast of Trumpets. Therefore, we must be mindful of the "last trump" mentioned in Revelation and be sure our minds are focused on heavenly things. Day of Atonement signifies the banishing of Satan, bringing us more "at one" with Yahweh.

The Holy Days will never cease. Even in the Kingdom, people will be punished if they do not observe them. Please read Zechariah 14: 17-19. It is obvious how serious Yahweh is about us observing His Holy Days!

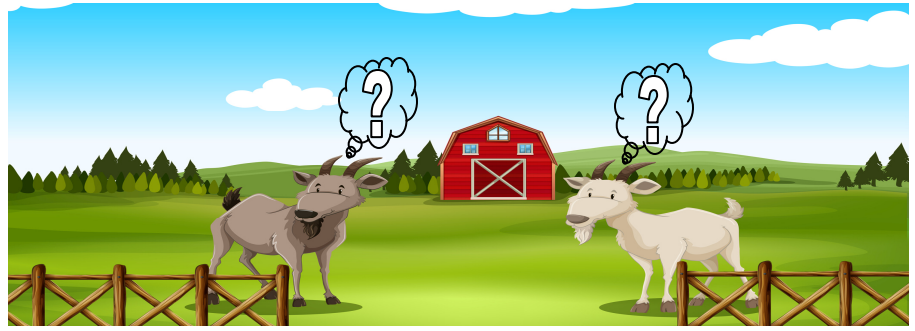
