

What is a Prophet?

A prophet is a person called by Yahweh to deliver His message to the people. In the Old Testament, we find many prophets. Some of them told about the future, while others served as leaders and advised kings. Some prophets even performed miracles, and others wrote down Yahweh's Words. Several Bible books were written by prophets: Jeremiah, Amos, Jonah, Micah, and others. The prophets not only spoke Yahweh's words, they lived them out in their own lives. Many prophets were thought of as the "watchman of the people."



In our modern Bibles, we have 17 prophetic books. The largest ones are Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, and Daniel. Many of the prophecies in the Bible have not vet come to pass! For instance, Yahweh's people are still anxiously awaiting the return of Yahshua the Messiah. are also anticipating the setting up of Yahweh's perfect Kingdom. The book of Isaiah gives exciting some glimpses of the coming Kingdom. It tells us even the na-

ture of animals will be changed!

It's true that some prophecies sound scary and seem like bad news. It is not particularly pleasant reading about wars, famines, diseases, and persecution. But Yahweh's people don't need to fear anything as long as they keep their focus on Yahweh. Yahweh's people have a wonderful future if they overcome to the end. You're never too young or too old to start striving toward a good relationship with your Heavenly Father!






