Being a widow in ancient times was often a death sentence. Widowed




women often had to rely on the kindness of strangers to give them food to survive, which was especially difficult during times of famine.

Naomi, Ruth's mother-in-law heard that the famine was finished in Judea, her native home. So she set out to return. Ruth clung to her, promising to embrace the ways of Yahweh. Ruth gave up everything that was familiar to her. We know that Moab was a very pagan nation. They worshipped the

false deity, Chemosh. Not much is known about Chemosh-worship, but the literal meaning of Chemosh is "destroyer." Chemosh was not a nice deity. It is very likely that Naomi had shared with Ruth all about Yahweh and Israel. Yahweh and His ways were certainly very attractive, compared to the awful blood-thirsty deities worshipped in the ancient world. Ruth surely recognized how different Yahweh was, in that He actually loved His people, unlike other deities back then! People only worshipped other deities out of fear, rather than love. So let us all reflect deeply on how blessed we are to have Yahweh as our Mighty One.
