WHO WAS ABRAHAM?

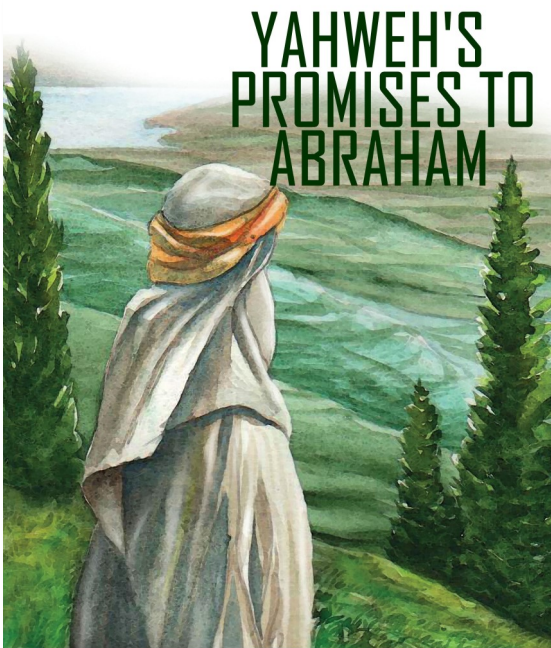
