

Counting to Pentecost!

We are now past Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread. Pentecost is the next Holy Day we will be keeping. The word Pentecost means "count fifty" in Greek. In the Hebrew, it was called Feast of Weeks because seven weeks were counted from Feast of Unleavened Bread.



In the New Testament, after Yahshua's death, Pentecost was very significant! It was the day that the Set Apart Spirit was sent to the early disciples. They were still keeping Pentecost as commanded. Prior to this time, the Holy Spirit was only given to certain people to carry out a specific purpose. But now the Holy Spirit is given to all people who believe, are baptized, and then have the elders lay hands on them to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Before His death, Yahshua had promised to send the "Comforter." Yahshua's disciples were told not to depart from Jerusalem but to

await the promise of the Father. Indeed, the Spirit was sent and appeared as tongues of fire above the disciples heads. It allowed them to speak in different languages.

Today, the Spirit of Yahweh is still working in Yahweh's people. We all receive a portion at baptism and the laying on of hands. The Spirit helps believers in many ways such as convicting us of sin so we may repent when we fall short. The Spirit is Yahweh's power and He allows us to share a portion with Him.

RULES TO LIVE BY FOR YAHWEH'S CHILDREN


- 1. Love Yahweh with all your heart.

- 20. Walk uprightly always.






