Pharaoh was a stubborn leader, but the last plague, the death of the firstborn, finally weakened him enough to let the slaves go. Pharaoh's own son was killed in the last plague. This was the first Passover. The death angel moved through the land destroying the first-born in the unmarked homes. The Israelites had marked their homes with lamb's blood, so



that the death angel would see the blood and "pass over" them, sparing their lives.

As you know, the Israelites had to leave Egypt so quickly that their bread did not have time to rise. This is the first time we see the Feast of Unleavened Bread, which all believers are required to keep, even today. We clean our homes of leaven and eat unleavened bread for the whole week. Leaven also can represent sin symbolically, so we also examine ourselves and recommit our lives to our Master, Yahshua, Who died for our sins. 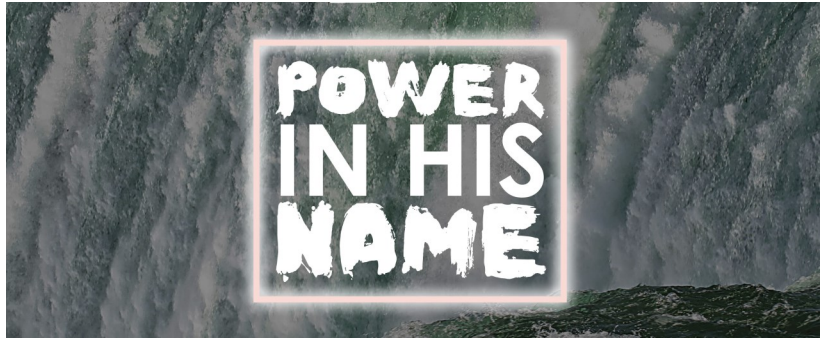
