The leaders in Yahshua's time

Yahshua had much trouble with the leaders of His day. In fact, He called the Pharisees, hypocrites! The word hypocrite means “actor,” in Greek. Yahshua chided the Pharisees, “You leaders make strict rules for the people to follow, but you do not keep them yourselves. You are careful to tithe on everything you own, even down to the tiny plants in your gardens. But you don’t obey the most important laws: being fair, showing kindness, and forgiving others. You are like a person who picks a fly out of his cup and then swallows a camel. You worry about a little mistake, but a big sin does not bother you” (Matt. 23:3, 23-25).



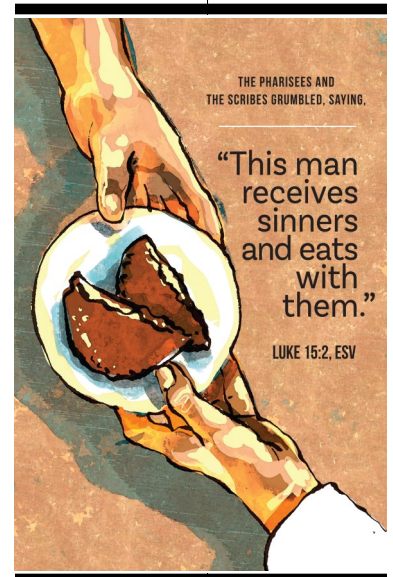
Yahshua also told the leaders of His day: “Woe unto you! Yahweh’s kingdom will be taken from you. It will be given to people who do the things that Yahweh wants. You know what the Scriptures say: ‘The Stone that the builders did not want became the Cornerstone.’ Yahshua is the Cornerstone (Psa. 118:22).

Yahshua had much grief when He walked upon this earth. He watched people’s faces as He rode through the city of Jerusalem. Even though the crowds were cheering, He knew that most of the people would choose not to believe His life-giving Words. Both His love for the people and deep sadness filled His heart. Yahshua cried out, “Jerusalem! Jerusalem! The time is coming when your enemies will destroy you. Not one of your buildings will be left. And the reason? Because Yahweh sent Me to save you, and you did not know it” (Luke 19:43-44).

For almost three years, Yahshua had been teaching about Yahweh. From the smallest village to the courtyard of the Temple, people everywhere spoke of His miraculous teachings. May Yahweh open the eyes of His people that they may be saved!

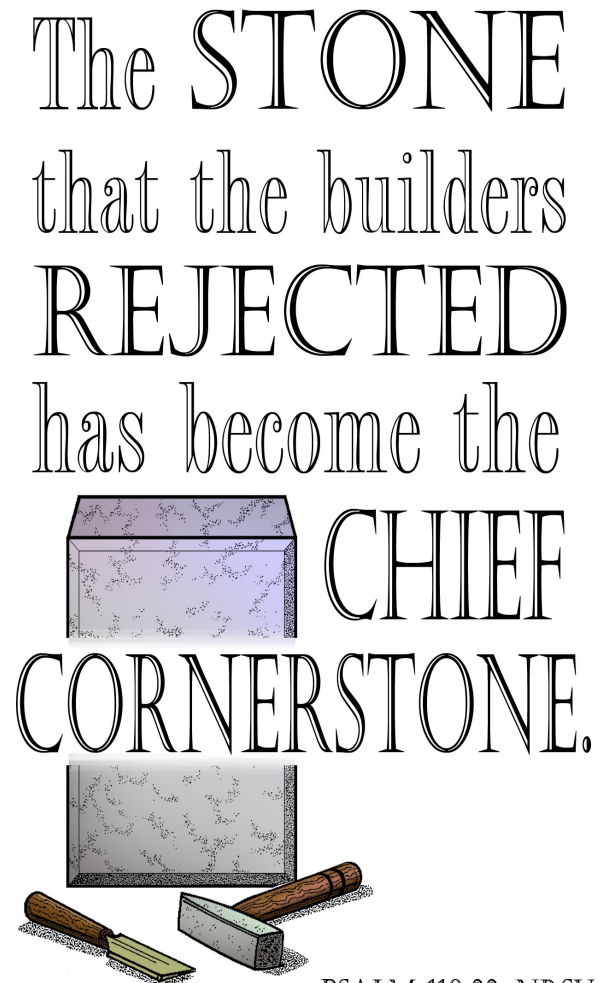

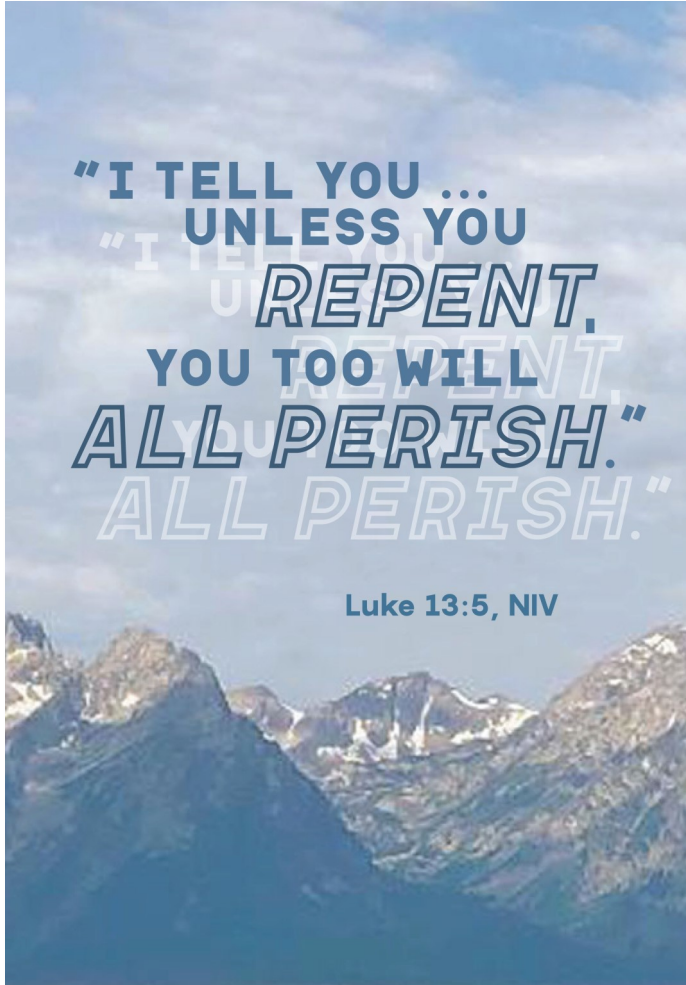
