

Come to the Feast!

We come now to Yahweh's final two fall Holy days, the Feast of Tabernacles and the Eighth Day. The Feast of Tabernacles is known as *sukkot* in the Hebrew. One thing that really sets Feast of Tabernacles apart from the other Holy Days is that we are commanded to be in a temporary dwelling for seven days. This could be a tent, cabin, motel room, RV, or lodge room. Following the Feast of Tabernacles is a separate Holy day called the Eighth Day. It is a "high day." You may be wondering, what is a high day? A high day is more special than the others. On most high days, we are not to do any work, and we are commanded to congregate.

The Feast of Tabernacles is a wonderful time picturing Yahweh's future Kingdom. We separate from the world and our regular jobs and schools, and



live together on a campground rented with other likeminded brethren. We feast happily on both physical and spiritual food. Eight days of Bible studies and daily messages help us learn and grow spirit-In addition, ually. fun activity days are planned which can help us bond as a family.

The Eighth day points to a time after the reign of Messiah

after the White Throne Judgment. It is a "time-out-of-time." It pictures the new heaven and new earth found in Revelation 20:14.

Keeping Yahweh's Holy Days are very important. Shortly after we return home from Yahweh's final two fall holy days, the world will be keeping a very evil holiday called Halloween. As Yahweh's people we avoid observing this holiday which celebrates evil, fear, and death. Yahweh's Holy Days give us hope and celebrate abundant life and reconciliation with Him.




