


Let's learn about new moons

Most people don't really think about the moon, except when they accidently see it on a clear night. But the moon was created by Yahweh for a very important reason! As you will see, we need to start thinking about the moon more often. Specifically, in Yahweh's time-keeping, a new moon begins a new month. In fact the word "month" comes from "moon." The new moon is the first visible crescent which appears in the western sky every 29 or 30 days just after sunset. Yahweh's calendar does not allow for 31 days as society's current secular calendar indicates.



Please be aware that the new moon is not the astronomical conjunction, when all is dark and no sliver is visible. It is also not the full moon.


One of Yahweh's Holy Days actually falls on a new moon! We are referring to the Feast of Trumpets. It is very important that we go out each month to look for the new moon. There may be times when our area is too cloudy to see the moon, but most likely brethren in other states will see it. This is why

we created our New Moon Report website to keep everyone informed, because we believe strongly that Yahweh has set in motion the heavenly bodies to establish the times and seasons. Read Genesis 1:14.

We also believe that we must view the moon with our naked eye. The Israelites did not have optical aids such as binoculars. It is also noteworthy that the new moon will also be kept to set Yahweh's Feasts in the future Millennium as we read in Isaiah 66:23, And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another and from one Sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before Me, says Yahweh. 
