He has also set eternity in the human heart, yet no one can fathom what Elohim has done from

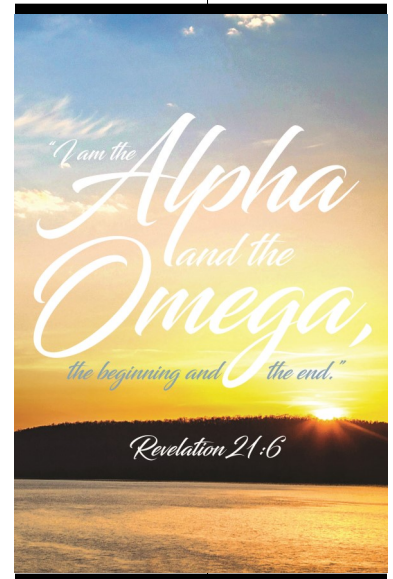


ECCLESIASTES 3:11, NIV

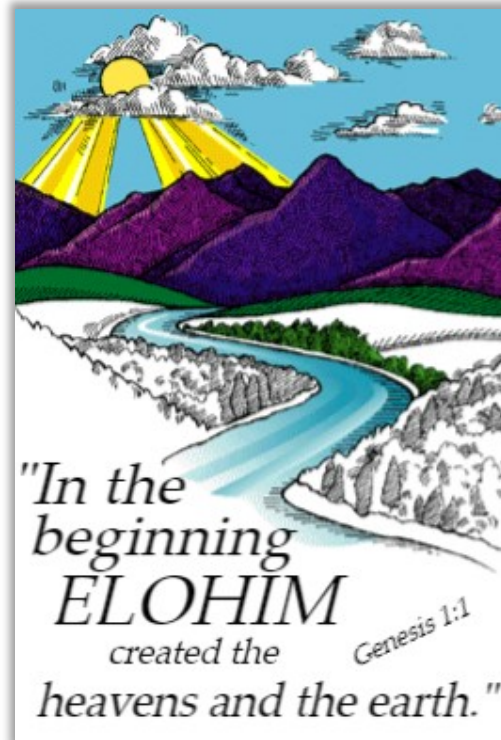

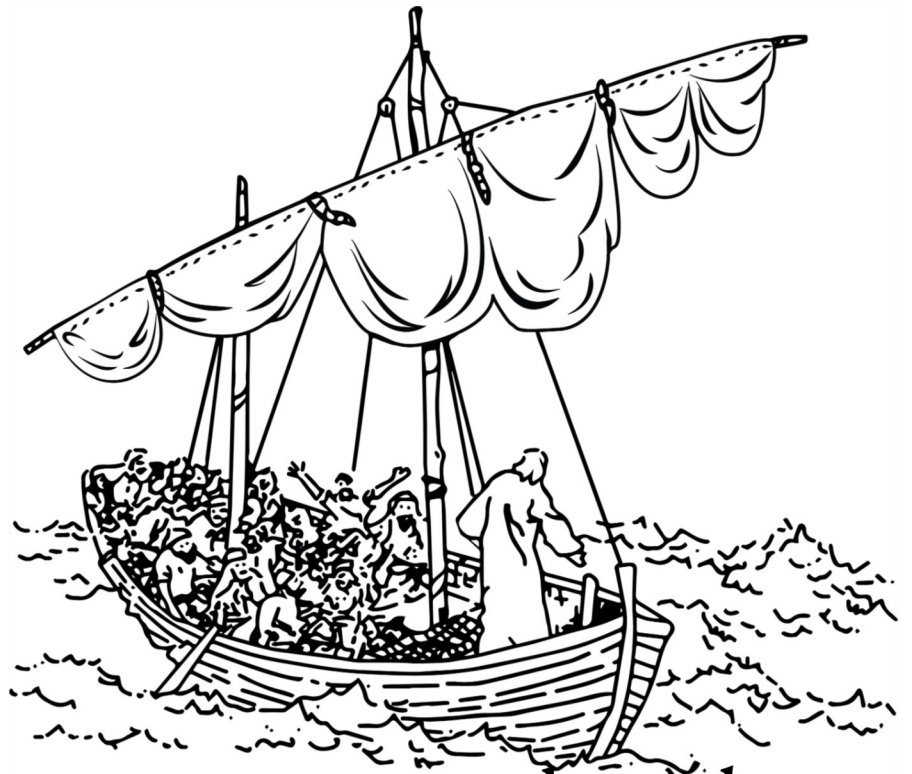
