To properly keep Yahweh's Holy Days, quite a bit of planning is involved, especially for the Feast of Tabernacles. We are required to travel to a location chosen by Yahweh, to dwell together for a whole week (longer if you include travel time, arrival and set up, and the Last Great Day). We are commanded to live in a temporary dwelling. This could be a tent, camper, motor home, motel room, cabin, lodge, or other means. Basically, it means we are to dwell in anything except our usual dwelling place. Other fall Holy days include Feast of Trumpet and Day of Atonement.

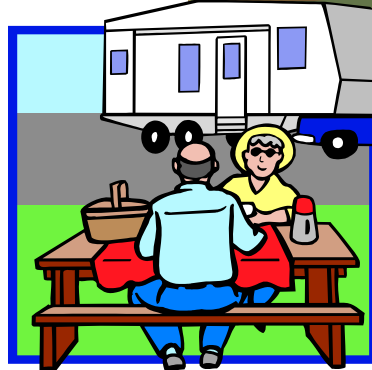
