## Was Yahshua really born on December 25th?

The so-called Christmas season is currently in full swing. You may be noticing Christmas music and decorations in stores and businesses. And you may even be hearing people talking out our Savior's "birthday." But what does Christmas have to do with Yahshua's birth? Absolutely nothing! Did you



know that the word "Christmas" can not be found in the Bible? This may be shocking to some people, but it's true! We at Yahweh's Assembly in Yahshua do not believe that Yahshua was born on December 25th. While no exact date is given in Scripture, we think the evidence points to Him being born in the fall, most likely around or

possibly during the Feast of Tabernacles. To go a step further, the Bible never commands us to celebrate Yahshua's birth anyway. We are told exactly what Holy Days we are to celebrate in Leviticus 23. We are not to add or take away from Scripture.

So why do people celebrate Christmas? The answers are not easy, but Christmas was not always celebrated as the birth of Messiah. Pagan peoples had been celebrating it for centuries under a different name. It was commonly known in the ancient Roman world as Saturnalia, in honor of their false deity Mithras.
