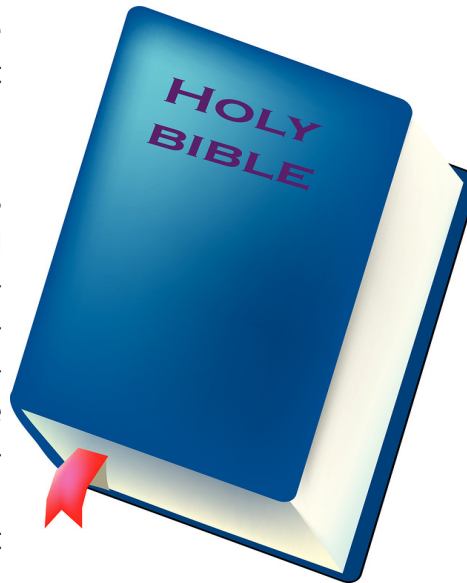

## Let's learn about the Bible!

If you are new to reading the Bible, you might be confused about many things. We'll try to clarify things a bit for you. First of all, the Bible is the most important book you will ever read. No other book even compares to the Bible, for it is Yahweh's own Word. You will find that the Bible is divided into two parts: the Old Testament (or Covenant) and the New Testament (or Covenant). There are 66 books total in the Bible, with 39 in the Old Testament and 27 in the New Testament.

One thing that scholars find unique about the Bible is that it has many authors, all who were inspired by Yahweh. Some scholars have identified at least 40 people that have authored books of the Bible. But ultimately, we know that Yahweh is the Author. Another thing is that the Bible spans more than a thousand years. Most of the authors did not even know each other.



The Old Testament was written in Hebrew and Aramaic, both of which are Semitic languages. While we believe, the New Testament was originally written in Hebrew and Aramaic, no complete surviving manuscripts are available. So, therefore, most of our New Testament translations come from the Greek language.

There is no right or wrong way to start reading the Bible. Some people read it from cover to cover. Others read one book from the Old Testament, then switch to one book in the New, then back to the Old, and continue on until the whole Bible is read. The most important thing is that you start reading! The Bible is truly life-changing.
