Packing for the Feast of Tabernacles!

If this is your first Feast of Tabernacles, you may feel overwhelmed about what to pack. Here's a handy packing list to help you:

- 1. Casual and dressy clothing. Mornings in October can sometimes be very chilly, so a light jacket or sweater will be helpful.
- 2. Head covering, scarf, or a hat (only for the ladies).
- 3. Shoes and socks.
- 4. Underwear and night clothes.
- 5. Bible, pen, and notebook (if you are planning to take notes).
- 6. Some snacks/breakfast food to tide you over until the first planned meal (which will be October 14th at noon).
- 7. Personal toiletries such as soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, floss, denture supplies, shampoo, conditioner, and deodorant.
- 8. Tent supplies (if you are camping).
- 9. Bedding such as sleeping bags, and/or sheets, pillows, pillow cases, blankets, and comforters.
- 10. Clothes hangers.
- 11. Towels and wash cloths.
- 12. Medications and/or supplements.
- 13. Umbrella (October can be rainy).
- 14. Plane, bus, or train tickets.
- 15. Passport (if applicable).
- 16. Chair cushion (camp chairs are usually not comfortable).

In addition:

- 1. Service your vehicle or RV, if applicable.
- 2. Put newspapers on hold.
- 3. Put mail on hold at your local post office.
- 4. Empty trash bins (you don't want to return home to a stinky home).
- 5. Use up any perishable food in your fridge at home.
- 6. Most of all, bring a joyful attitude!
















Furthering the Good News


There is always more than one way to look at every situation. What might seem like a bad situation may actually be a blessing in disguise. It's always a good idea to ask Yahweh to make you aware of how He could use your present circumstances to bless others. Perhaps someone around you needs to see the difference Yahweh's presences makes in your life. Are you willing for Yahweh to use your circumstances to demonstrate His saving power to those around you?

Often when we encounter a new situation, our first thoughts are not about Yahweh's Kingdom. When we face a crisis, we can become angry and fearful for our own well-being (which is perfectly natural), rather than looking to see what Yahweh intends to do through our circumstances. It's interesting to read the Apostle Paul's writings, as he always seemed to be concerned with how his circumstances might aid the spread of the Good News of Yahweh's Kingdom. In fact, Paul said in Philippians 1:12, "But I want you to know, brethren, that the things which have happened to me have actually turned out for the furtherance of the evangel." Wow! I rarely hear modern believers say such things (including myself, regrettably).

Think of the things Paul went through. Being shipwrecked on an island would probably never be his most pleasant memory, yet he even used that situation to share the evangel to those on the island. He even used his unjust imprisonment to share Yahweh's salvation to others. Read the following Scriptures for more information: Acts 16: 19-34 and Acts 26:132.

DO YOU LOVE PEACE


Have you ever met a person who wanted to always argue about everything? Sadly, we find some believers in this category. They want to debate even the silliest things, and always think that only their opinion is correct. When it comes to Scripture, there will always be differences of understanding among brethren as we are all at different levels in our spiritual walks. But we are to strive for peace! We are especially supposed to be merciful towards new believers.



The truth of Yahweh is within us; we never need to be intimidated and frustrated by those who do not accept Yahweh's truth. At times, people may even disagree with you or challenge your faith in Yahweh. It may upset you, but it is never helpful to argue with them. You will never debate anyone into Yahweh's Kingdom. Persuading someone is highly unlikely when tempers flare and harsh words are spoken.

Sharing our faith with others is certainly important, but it's also important to know when to

drop the subject. Instead, wait for clear cues that a person is really interested. And always try to be ready if the opportunity to share your faith naturally presents itself. A person may be interested if they ask you questions about your faith. It may be an open door from Yahweh. And never expect a person to be converted overnight. Conversion can take many years. Most of all, strive for peace in all situations if possible!


It is the Master Potter who changes old to new

1 can 16 ounce refrigerated flaky biscuits.

1 cup of your favorite pizza sauce.

2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese.

16 slices turkey pepperoni (or your favorite toppings), opt.



Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Cut each biscuit into 8 pieces. In a large bowl, mix biscuits with sauce and 1 cup cheese. Press into ungreased 9 inch pan. Top with your favorite toppings and remaining cheese. Bake about 22 minutes or until hot and bubbly.

Make store-bought brownie mix even better!

Prepare brownie mix according to package directions, then top with one of the following neat combinations before putting in the oven:

- 1. Caramel popcorn and melted dark chocolate.
- 2. Tropical trail mix.
- 3. Shredded coconut, sweetened condensed milk, toasted sliced almonds, and melted dark chocolate.
- 4. Chocolate chip cookie dough plus M&M's.
- 5. Dry roasted peanuts, tiny pretzels, and melted caramels.
- 6. Cherry pie filling and a dusting of powdered sugar.
- 7. Cheesecake filling, apricot preserves, and chopped dried apricots.
- 8. Fresh raspberries, pistachios, and a light dusting of sea salt.
- 9. Mini kosher marshmallows, mini chocolate bar pieces, and small pieces of honey graham crackers.
