Philippine Brethren

Brother Lucas and I were blessed to have traveled to the Philippines for three weeks this last month of August. The trip there was not without trouble, with a canceled flight initially and lost luggage, but the flight was changed, and the luggage was recovered. With those things out of the way, the rest of the trip was truly a blessing.

The Philippine brethren are a joy to be around as they express the fruits of the Spirit in their lives. They love to praise Yahweh and lift one another up in Messiah Yahshua. There was consistency we saw in the three regions of Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao where we traveled.

Brethren also traveled to meet at three different assembly locations we attended, but there were many brethren we were not able to meet with. Currently, there are about twenty assemblies, up from three just twenty years ago. We have reason to go back and continue to support further growth. In fact, one well-established assembly joined with YAIY while we were there the first week.

There are 117,000,000 people in the Philippines, with over 7600 islands in 17 regions. So, there is still room to grow as the Word of Yahweh continues to be proclaimed. Because of the various provinces, there are different languages spoken, but Tagalog and Visayan are two of the major dialects. At a Board of Directors meeting in Zamboanga, it was agreed further translations should be made, in particular the 21-lesson *YAIY Bible Correspondence Course*.

While in the Philippines, we had one baptism, the appointment of two deacons, and the anointing of four elders overall who had been deacons for many years previously. All these have supportive and believing wives in the faith.

There was also a new assembly building that was dedicated to the work of Yahweh on the last Sabbath we were there. Our prayer is that the work will continue to grow and that not only brethren in the Philippines but around the world will be readied for rulership under Yahshua the Messiah when He returns. Let us all prepare for that time to come and continue to teach, "Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand."



If It Be Possible ...

If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men, Romans 12:18.

Inasmuch as Yahweh has called us to peace, we should actively seek and pursue it. Nevertheless, life experience informs us, that it is not possible to live peaceably with all, as much confirmed by Yahshua Who affirmed it was impossible but that offences would come, but Who also declared woe to him by whom and through whom they should come.

Key, is ruling our own spirits, so we don't become the vehicles by, and through whom, offenses proceed ... always mindful, that as exemplary of believers in word, behavior, love, spirit, faith, and purity, we will foster the answer of a good conscience void of offense toward man, and hence, toward Yahweh. To this end, we don't company with angry, contentious people and avoid striving about words to no profit (debates) that may lead to tumult, and we quietly mark and withdraw from them whose speech and conduct are disorderly.

Because it's not possible for two to walk together, except they be agreed, when you meet someone who doesn't yet have your knowledge and understanding, rather than challenge their weak conscience of faith with declaratory statements, ask questions which invite inquiry or consideration. For example, instead of saying to someone, "You shouldn't be using false names like Jesus, or titles like God and Lord," ask instead, "Doesn't it make sense to you that a Hebrew Baby born of a Hebrew woman should be given a Hebrew Name?" Then, if interest is shown by the other, you may tell them the Savior's Name is Yahshua, and His Father's Name is Yahweh.

Remember, *the servant of Yahweh must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if Yahweh peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the Truth; and that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the dEvil, who are taken captive by him at his will, 2 Timothy 2:24-26.*
