

Yahweh Provides

The Israelites had seen that Yahweh's Words were true; He had brought them safely out of Egypt and ended their slavery, just as He had promised. But, once they were in the wilderness, they grumbled and complained that there was no food or water. Had Yahweh forgotten them?



Yahweh answered their grumblings. He commanded Moses to strike a rock with his stick. Water enough for all poured from the rock. Then Yahweh gave Moses a message for the people: "Every evening, you will have meat. And every morning you can have all the bread you want. Then you will know I am Yahweh, your Elohim" (Ex. 16:12).

At night, small birds covered the ground. The people caught them and cooked them for their meal. In the morning, the desert was white with thin flakes. The people named this delicious bread from heaven "manna." In the Hebrew, "manna" means, "what is it?" Manna tasted like wafers with honey.

So Yahweh provided sustenance for

His people. But on the sixth day, they were commanded to gather twice as much as they needed, because the Sabbath day was coming. There was to be no gathering food on Sabbath. Yahweh was teaching His people to rest every Sabbath, on the seventh day.

And likewise, we must also observe Sabbath too! We work for six days, then rest on the seventh, just as Yahweh has commanded from the beginning of creation. Even Yahweh set the standard by resting on the seventh day after He created everything. The Sabbath is truly a day of joy. We are not to do our own pleasure, but we are to spend the day resting with our families and honoring our heavenly Father.
