


WHO WAS NIMROD?

Noah had three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth. Ham and his wife had children and eventually grandchildren. One of Ham's grandsons was named Nimrod. We are not told many details about Nimrod, but he grew to be a very strong man. In fact, he was responsible for establishing a very large empire which included the evil city of Babel. Eventually Yahweh scattered the people who built the Tower of Babel and confused their languages.

It is quite obvious that Nimrod did not like or obey Yahweh. In fact, he taught the people false ideas against Yahweh. Historically-speaking, many false ideas about worship came about during Nimrod's time, such as the worship of the sun, moon and stars, which Yahweh clearly forbade. (See Deuteronomy 4:19.) False religions of men are made with the help of Satan, the devil. He causes people to disobey and rebel against Yahweh. The Bible says the whole world is deceived. When we do not obey Yahweh, we cannot understand our purpose in life and why Yahweh has made us.

Yahweh has always wanted a relationship with the people He created. The only way we can be right with Yahweh is to forsake our evil ways and begin following

Him. Yahweh has a whole new lifestyle for a person who submits to Him. Yahweh alone has the right to tell us what is right and wrong. We cannot make our own rules. Let us seek Yahweh with our whole hearts, so that we can have a right relationship with Him!




