


WHO WAS MOSES?

Since we are just coming out of Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread, let's go a little deeper into the life of Moses. The Israelites had so many children when they were slaves in Egypt, that Pharaoh worried that the Israelites would become more numerous than the Egyptians. So Pharaoh ordered that all Hebrew baby boys delivered were to be killed. But the midwives did not honor Pharaoh's request. Yahweh blessed the midwives for their faithfulness and gave them families of their own.



One Israelite mother was determined to save her baby! She put him in a basket and placed him in the river. The baby was found by pharaoh's daughter. She named him Moses, which roughly translates, "to draw out of the water." Pharaoh's daughter loved him and reared him in Pharaoh's own house.

So the Israelites continued to multiply in Egypt. The Egyptians made them into slaves and treated them cruelly. The Israelites cried out to Yahweh. This is when Yahweh called Moses to lead them out of Egypt. Yahweh, through Moses and his brother, Aaron, did very powerful and frightening things in Egypt, because Pharaoh refused to let the Hebrews go.

While Moses was not a perfect man by any means, Yahweh used him in a mighty way to accomplish one of the greatest events in Hebrew history! The plagues poured down on Egypt were all against the false deities of Egypt. Pharaoh was so stubborn that it took the death of the firstborns to finally move him to obey Yahweh's command to release the Israelites. We can learn powerful lessons from this!


