Diffusing Situations Which Make You Angry

A relationship can sometimes degenerate due to negativity. Let your own behavior be positive at all times. One approach toward being more positive, is to ask another to help you by letting you know when they feel you are being negative. When conversations become heated, there are some ways to help turn down the temperature.

- ⇒ Don't snap at the bait – *Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger, James 1:19;*
- ⇒ Let your own words stay calm, positive and few – *When words are many, transgression is not lacking, but whoever restrains his lips is prudent, Proverbs 10:19;*
- ⇒ Excuse yourself for a few minutes. Let things settle down – *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law, Galatians 5:22-23;*
- ⇒ When you return, apologize, and say something positive and compliment what you both value in your relationship;
- ⇒ Tell the other person you can see their point, and that you appreciate their willingness to work together toward a solution.

The goal is to resolve the problem and then drop it, forever. Of course, this can be hard to do. Sometimes, we try to avoid talking about a problem and

yet, we're unable to erase it from memory. Yahshua told us that maintaining anger in our hearts is not acceptable. He declared that if we from our hearts forgive not everyone their trespasses, neither shall we have forgiveness from our Heavenly Father (Matt. 6:15, 18:35).

Christian Sabbath?

Some will say that they obey the “Christian Sabbath,” but when asked if they observe the 7th day Sabbath, the day called “Saturday,” they admit that they actually keep the 1st day of the week called “Sunday.”

Keeping another day holy, other than what Yahweh made holy, is lawlessness and a lie in general. Sunday came into being as an adjustment to fit in with the pagan “Sun” worship. Hence, the day “Sun-day” was instituted as law by a man named Constantine, who was a pagan sun worshipper himself. The Emperor Constantine’s law said:

“All judges, city people and craftsmen shall rest on the venerable day of the Sun. But countrymen may without hindrance attend to agriculture, since it so often happens that this day for sowing grain or planting vines, so that the opportunity afforded by divine providence may not be lost, for the right season is short. 7 March 321 [C.E.]” (*Cod. Justinianus III xii 3*) **Introduction to the History of Christianity**, by Dr. Tim Dowley, Fortress Press, 1995, page 152.

It is interesting to note that Constantine made sure that the food harvests were uninterrupted. He may have been aware of the Sabbatical land rest that believers in Yahweh were to keep. In a sense he may have, as the saying goes, “killed two birds with one stone.”

Anointing With Oil

Anointings with olive oil have occurred in the past (Exod. 28:41) and are still occurring today with prayer, for the reason of setting apart an individual for a special purpose. Elders are set apart for the spiritual ministry, and leadership of the assembly. While deacons receive only the laying on of hands and prayer, they are still set apart for a special service of the physical needs of brethren and work in general, (Acts 6:1-6).

The laying on of hands after baptism is, interestingly enough, done without oil. The Spirit of Yahweh seals, and in a sense, anoints the individual (Luke 4:18; Acts 10:38), setting him or her apart as a special person in the family of Yahweh (1 John 2:20, 27), most notably the collective bride who is preparing herself for Yahshua’s return (Rev 19:7).

A certificate of completion will be given to all who complete the course which is made of twenty one lessons, three of which cover two subjects each.

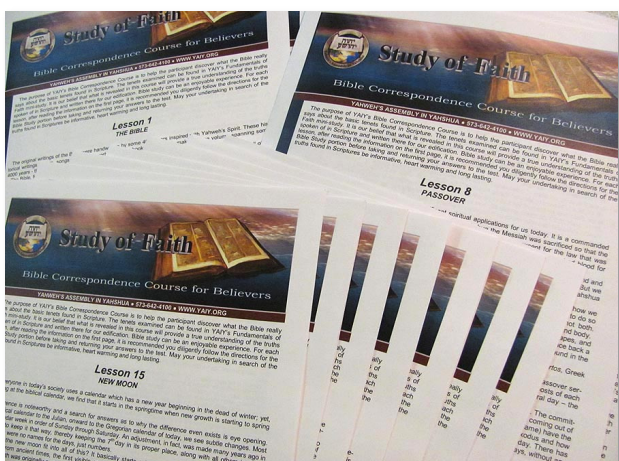
Each lesson may seem to be short initially, but when one goes through and looks up all the relative Scripture verses, the depth and insight of each lesson will become apparent.

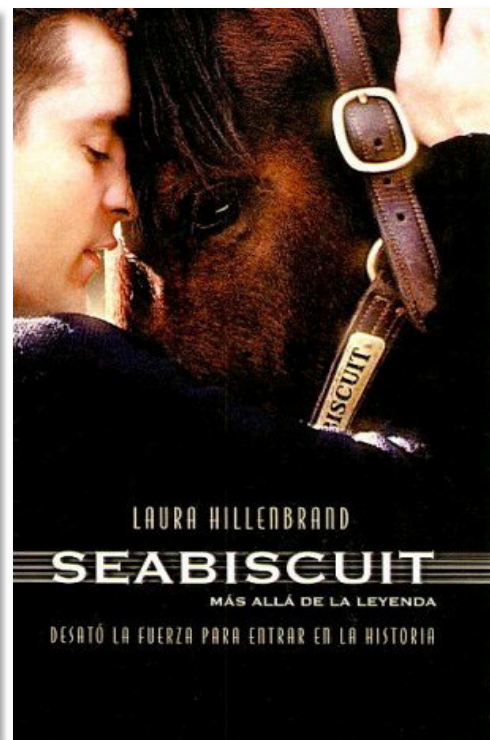
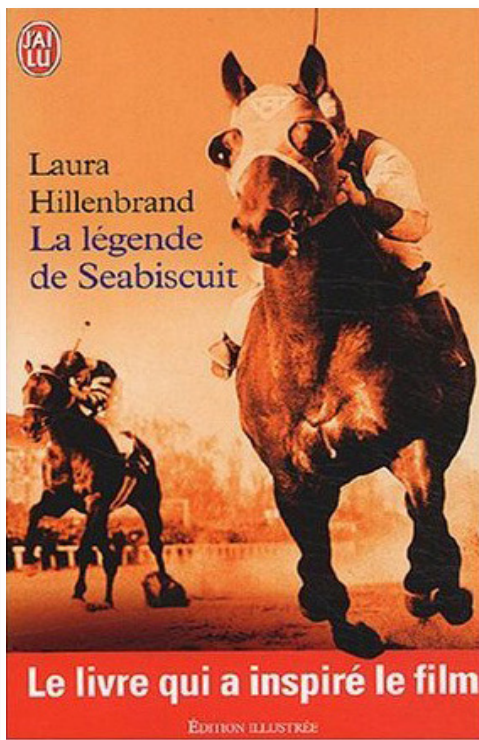
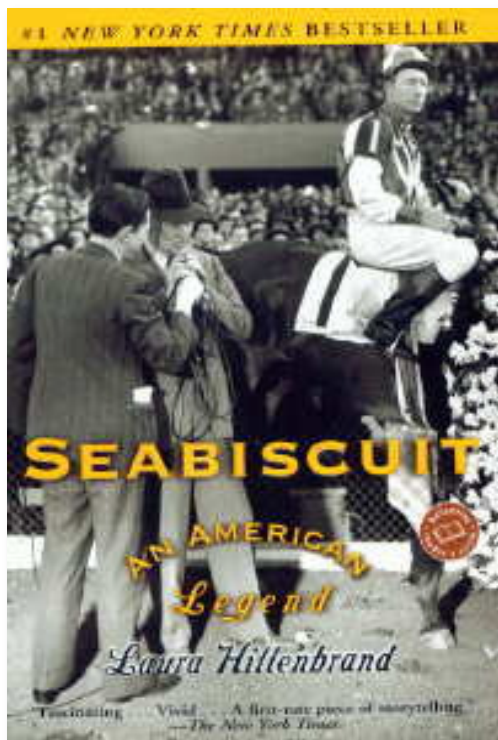
Seabiscuit: An American Legend

The Son's Name

Many are waking up to the fact that the Messiah's Name originally spoken by the disciples was indeed of the Semitic tongue, and attuned closely to "Yeshua" with the correction of the shortened poetic form of "Yah" included rather than the "Yeh" being pronounced.

The confusion has come about with the vowel pointing of Pharisaical men in the past. The tradition continues by many well-meaning scholars today who just don't want to upset the applecart, so to speak.

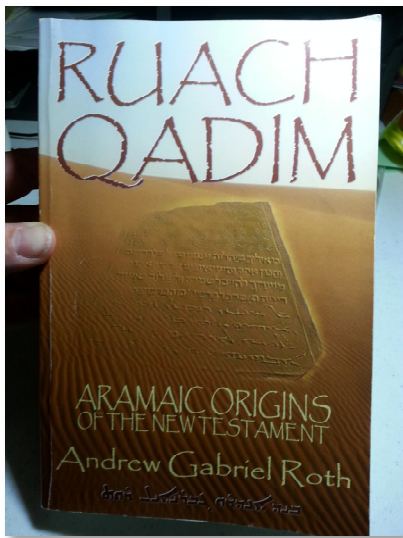
Some will readily admit that the Savior's Name holds the meaning of "Yahweh is Salvation," but will write or say either "Jesus" or "Yeshua" keeping with the tradition. While the letters found in the Semitic New Testament for the Savior are correctly expressed as "Y'shua," we understand that phonetically it was pronounced as "Yahshua" by the disciples of the Messiah's day without the vowel pointing.

Andrew Gabriel Roth was born and raised knowing the Aramaic language. Professors of the language will admit that even with 25 years of study into the language, one will not know it as well as someone who grew up speaking and writing it.

Mr. Roth also learned Hebrew and Greek in his own studies and research.

Below he is clarifying in Acts 4:12, the spelling (seen to the right) which we see have abbreviated, showing the correct pronunciation. The Son's Name is Y[ah]shua.

"And gave him a name greater than all names (*Yah, not El*). That by the name of Y'shua (*Yah Saves*) every knee will bow, of those that are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue will confess that YHWH is Y'shua Meshikha, to the glory of Elohim his Father."
