## Is Easter found in the Bible?

In our last issue, we learned about Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread. Briefly, we touched upon the pagan holiday called Easter, which often falls near Yahweh's spring Holy Days. We believe that Easter is a counterfeit which wrongly replaced Passover. People who celebrate Easter believe they are doing it in honor of Yahshua's resurrection. But many don't realize that Easter is actually a very old fertility rite which was celebrated long before Yahshua was even born.



Even the name Easter comes from a pagan goddess named Ishtar, which was also known as the Queen of Heaven. Yahweh was greatly angered by the worship of the Queen of Heaven. We do well to avoid participating in a holiday which clearly displeases Yahweh.

If you think about it, many of the customs of Easter are very odd. Pastel-colored dyed eggs and chocolate bunny rabbits have nothing to do with Yahshua. However, eggs and rabbits were considered symbols of fertility long ago.

It is also of interest that we are told in Scripture that Yahshua was in the tomb for three days and three nights.

Those who celebrate Easter claim that you can fit his death, burial, and resurrection into a period known as Good Friday through Easter Sunday. Try as you may, there is no possible way to fit three days and three nights in that time period.

In the *King James Bible*, you can actually find the word "Easter." However, it is easily proven that it was a mistranslation of the word "pesach" which means Passover! It is our mission to restore the truths of Scripture which have been covered up by misguided translators.
