


The Master's Prayer

Read Matthew 6:5-14. We can learn much about prayer in these verses. Yahshua's disciples requested of Him, "Master, teach us to pray!" Such a simple four-word request. But Yahshua had much to say about the important topic of prayer. First and foremost, in simple terms, prayer is having a conversation with our Heavenly Father, Yahweh.



Yahshua replied, "Don't pray like a hypocrite standing in a synagogue or street corner only to be seen by others." We shouldn't make a show out of our deep conversations with Yahweh. While collective prayer together in the Assembly is good, private prayer is also a great idea. We should go into our rooms and shut the door, but not like babbling pagans who think they will be heard for their many words. Prayer should be deep and meaningful, not vain repetition. Here is how Yahshua taught His disciples to pray:

"Our Father Who is in heaven. Hallowed (set apart, holy, sacred) be Your Name. Your Kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give

us this day our daily bread (may our needs be met). Forgive us our debts, and we forgive our debtors. Lead us not into temptation (keep us safe from anything that would lure us away from Yahweh), but deliver us from the evil one (Satan, the devil.). For Yours is the Kingdom and the power and the glory forever. May it be so (Amein, in the Hebrew).

If we are Yahweh's people, we can be bold in coming to Him in prayer! He delights in our prayers.




