Why did Yahshua wash the disciples' feet?

Two thousand years ago, customs were very different in the land of Israel from what we see today. A question recently came up about foot washing practices. In Yahshua's day, people walked everywhere and their feet would become very dirty and dusty. It was a servant's job to wash people's feet when they entered a house. This is why the disciples were very surprised and confused when Yahshua told them he was about to wash their feet before taking the emblems of unleavened bread and grape juice. Yahshua was Yahweh's own Son! The disciples could not imagine Him being a lowly servant. Peter even got offended and declared, "You will never wash my feet, Master!"



Foot Washing

Indeed, baptized adults in Yahweh's Assembly do wash each other's feet before taking the emblems, as Yahshua taught His disciples to do.

By washing the disciples feet, Yahshua showed us that we should help other people, no matter how dirty the job. Of course, serving others is not limited to footwashing. In our modern world, foot washing is seen as strange. Service to others can include praying for people, helping each other with tasks, and in many other ways.

Since we mentioned the "emblems," let's explore this briefly. We eat unleavened bread because it symbolizes Yahshua's body which was broken for us. We drink grape juice (not wine) because it symbolizes His blood which was shed for us. We just finished Passover in April and now are looking forward to Pentecost this Month of June on the 16th!

But Yahshua replied, "Yes, Peter, I have washed your feet. Therefore, follow My example and serve one another. A servant is not greater than his master. And a messenger is not greater than the one who sent him."

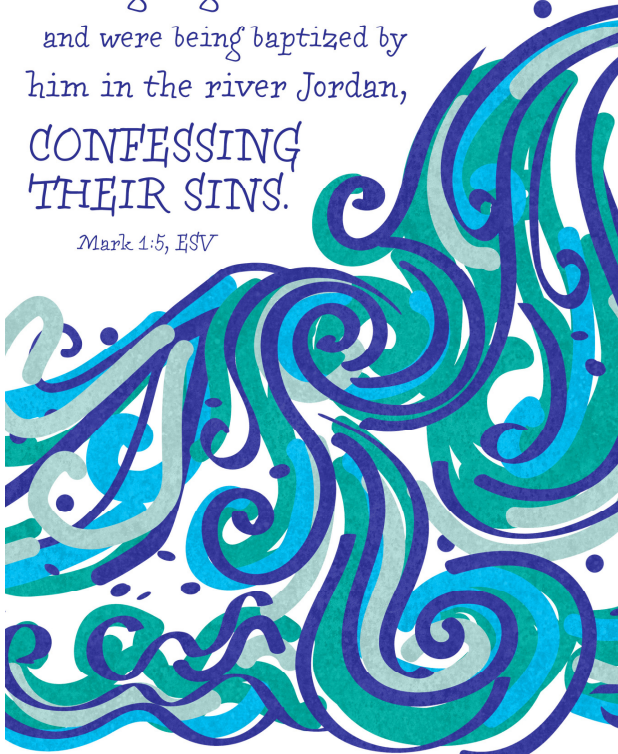
